Henry Dace being the land to which he
is entitled by virtue of affidavit No 7 made in accordance
with an act approved November 12th 1866 granting 160
acres of land to actual settlers he having perfected his
former Preemption Claim upon the same land said Survey
is ^{situated in Boisgue County} on the waters of Meridian Creek a tributary of the
Red River ^{about 7 miles N 33 E of Meridian} beginning at the N. E. Corner of ^{the eastern}
Survey in the name of D. B. Stockbridge a Pile of Rocks
forth the N. E. Corner of this survey
Thence N 30^o W. 950 varas to the N. E. Corner from whence
a Cedar marked X. is 33 E 100 varas
Thence S. 60^o W. 950 varas to the N. E. Corner a Pile of Rocks
Thence S. 30^o E. 950 varas to the S. W. Cor in the north line
of D. B. Stockbridge a Pile of Rocks
Thence N 60^o E. 950 varas with the line of Stockbridge
to the beginning

beginning on the 15th day of May 1868 that he is the head

of obtaining a title to the same for a home-stead under an Act

Public Lands of ^{the State of} ~~Texas~~" approved March 24 1871, and that
he has not a homestead other than the above. And also




