declares that he is a Bona Fide settler upon one hundred
and sixty acres of Vacant public land, situated in
said County and surveyed for Emshly Roberts on the
25th day of May AD 1868 by Ward Keeler Surveyor of
said County, that he has occupied and improved the same
as a home stead for the period of three consecutive years
beginning on the 20th day of May 1868 and that he is the head
of a family and that he makes this affidavit for the
purpose of obtaining a title to the same for a home
stead under an Act Supplementary to "An Act
to regulate the Disposal of the Public Lands of the State of Texas
Approved March 24th 1871 and that he has not a home
stead other than the above, And also at the same
time came and personally appeared Jesse Thomas
and Henry Davel two credible resident Citizens
of said County, to me well known, who being duly sworn, before
me and say that Emshly Roberts the person first above named
in this affidavit, has actually settled upon and cultivated
as a home stead the land surveyed for him on the 25th day
of May 1868 by the surveyor aforesaid, for the period of three
years, and they nor neither of them have any interest in the
said land
