land to actual Settler which is herewith filed he being the  
head of a family <sup>situated in Bosque County</sup> since Survey is on the waters of Meridian Creek <sup>about 12 miles S<sup>W</sup> of Meridian</sup>

Beginning at the N<sup>W</sup> Corner of a Survey of  
160 acres made for Elias H. Skensland by Ward Keeler March  
the 8<sup>th</sup> 1866. Which Corner is S. 60<sup>o</sup> W. 109 Varas and S. 30<sup>o</sup> E. 230 Varas  
from the S. E. Corner of W. W. Smith's Survey

Thence N. 60<sup>o</sup> E. 480 Varas a Pile of Rocks in the North

Before Me, the undersigned, District Clerk, In and for the county aforesaid, this day came and personally appeared Andrew Johnson a resident citizen of said county, who being by me duly sworn, declares that he is a bona fide settler upon 160 acres of vacant public land, situated in said county, and surveyed for Andrew Johnson on the 15th day of August, 1868. by Ward Beecher, Surveyor of said county; that he has occupied and improved the same as a homestead for the period of three consecutive years, beginning on the 1st day of Augt. 1868 that he is a married man. - and that he makes this affidavit for the purpose of obtaining a title to the same for a homestead under ~~An Act supplementary to~~ "An Act for the benefit of actual occupants of the Public Lands," approved May 26, 1873, and that he has not a homestead other than the above.

And also at the same time came and personally appeared J. H. Lee, and C. O. Strand, two credible resident citizens of said county, to me well known, who being duly sworn, depose and say that Andrew Johnson, the person first above named in this affidavit, has actually settled upon and cultivated as a homestead the land surveyed for him on the 15th day of August 1868 by the Surveyor aforesaid, for the period of three years, and they nor either of them have any interest in the said land.
