Bosque County, of Land made for Ole Canutson

Being the land to which he is entitled by
virtue of affidavit No 13 made in accordance with an
act approved November 1866, and file in my office in
Land is situated ^{in Bosque County} ^{about 13 miles South of Mexia.} on the waters of Hell Creek being a part
of the land surveyed for Charles Powers when not subject-
to location and the certificate withdrawn and it also
did conflict with Ole Olson's Survey

Beginning at the S.E. corner of Ole Olson's Survey
for the N.E. corner of this from which a live oak marked A.
brs. N 33° E. 56 1/2 varas & another marked B. brs. N 21° E 600 vs.
Thence S 60° W. 1310 varas to the East line of Canute Canutson's
Survey a pile of rocks for the N.W. corner
Thence S. 30° E. 270 varas to the North line of Ole Canutson's for
the S.W. corner of this a pile of rocks
Thence N. 30° E. 610 varas with Canutson's North line to the
N.E. corner of Canutson's Survey
Thence S. 30° E. 680 varas with the East line of Canutson to the
N.W. corner of a Survey in the name of ^{C. P. Powers} Whitehurst a pile
of rocks. Thence N 60° E. 700. varas to the S.W. corner
of a Survey in the name of Hensel Coburn in Prairie
Thence N 30° W. 950 varas to the beginning.
