To be located upon a part of the vacant and unappropriated Public Domain of the State of Texas, in accordance with the provisions of "An Act in relation to the Corpus Christi Ship Canal," passed May 23, 1873.

Information having been received from His Excellency, the Governor, that he had approved the report, made by the Inspector, that the Canal has been completed in accordance with the provisions of the above entitled Act.

The lands hereby granted are to be located in alternate sections, and surveyed in the following manner:

First, Two sections of land adjoining and connecting with each other must be surveyed, one for the State and the other for Morris & Cumings, agents for the City of Corpus Christi.

Second, The surveys to be made square, unless prevented by pre-existing surveys or navigable streams.

Third, When the fieldnotes have been returned to the General Land Office, the Commissioner will number the surveys and report the result to the surveyor, who will fill up the blanks left in his record for that purpose, accordingly. (As a matter of convenience in describing the surveys, when reporting the numbers, the surveyor shall number the field notes, temporarily, in pencil.)

Fourth, In dividing the surveys, a fraction of over three hundred and twenty acres will be counted as a whole section; and two fractions of less than three hundred and twenty acres will be counted as a section.

Fifth, The even numbers will be reserved to the State, and the odd numbers to become the property of Morris and Cumings, agents for the City of Corpus Christi.

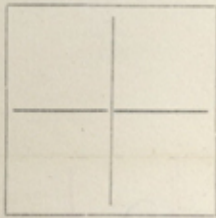
This correction begins at Wells N.W. cor. a survey which is superseded by a duplicate and of no validity Sec 3-2431. The survey seems not to be very well posted about the distance between back S. line & Well marks S. line & others with the complements of the adjoining surveys not with the connecting lines run by J. De Cordes, by which connecting lines the W. line of John Shipleps survey appears larger on the ground than its field notes call for. The surveyor must run the lines on the ground and state the facts as he finds them.
