County aforesaid this day came and personally
appeared Calvino Acuff, a resident citizen
of said County who being by me duly sworn
declares that he is a Bonafide Settler upon one
Hundred & Sixty acres of vacant public land
situated in said County and surveyed for
said Calvino Acuff on the 27th day of March
1869 by "Ward" Keeler Surveyor of
said County, that he has occupied and
improved the same as a homestead for
the period of three consecutive years
beginning on the 16th day of March 1869
that he is a Married Man and that he
makes this affidavit for the purposes of
obtaining a title to the same for a home-
stead under An Act supplementary to an
Act to regulate the disposal of the public
lands of the State of Texas, approved March
24th 1871 and that he has not a homestead
other than the above, And also at the same time
came and personally appeared D B Scott
and J R Arnold two credible citizens of
said County, to me well known who being duly
sworn depose and say that
the person first above named in this affida-
vit has actually settled upon and cultivated
as a homestead the land surveyed for him
on the 27th day of March 1869 by the surveyor
aforesaid for the period of three years and
they nor either of them have any interest
in said land
