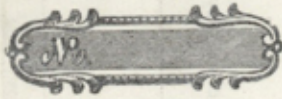

Said Land is situated in Bosque County, about *7* miles *South* from Meridian, on the waters of _____ Creek: begining *NW cor of George Romee presumption* and more particularly described by the accompanying field notes.
