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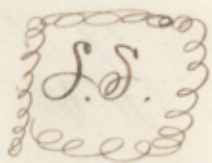

Bosque County, which affidavit was lost or
mislaid, and was in the words and figures
as follows, to wit:

Bosque County this day personally
appeared Sars Nelson, to me known, who after
being ^{by me duly} sworn, upon his oath deposes and says: that
he is now a Bona Fide settler upon One Hundred
and sixty acres of Land, that he believes to be of
the public vacant Lands of the State of Texas;
that he is improving said Land for a Homestead,
and has no other land further that he is a mar-
ried man, and makes this Affidavit for the purpose
of obtaining a Home. Said Land is situated in Bosque
County about Five miles south from Meudian, on
the waters of Bee Creek Beginning at the N.E.
corner of the Hubbell Survey and more particularly
described by the accompanying field notes.

Proof of Settlement under Homestead Act.

BEFORE ME, the undersigned, County Clerk in and for the County aforesaid, this day came and personally appeared Lars Nilson a resident citizen of said County, who being by me duly sworn, declares that he is a bona fide settler upon One hundred & Sixty acres of vacant public land, situated in said County, and surveyed for Lars Nilson on the 28th day of January 1877, by L. H. B. Crutchfield a Surveyor of said County; that he has occupied and improved the same as a Homestead for a period of three consecutive years, beginning on the 25th day of January 1872 that he is a Married man and that he makes this affidavit for the purpose of obtaining a title to the same for a Homestead, under an Act supplementary to "An Act for the Benefit of Actual Occupants of the Public Lands," approved May 26th, 1873, and Acts prior thereto; and that he has not a Homestead other than the above.

AND also at the same time came and personally appeared, Evan Erickson and Lauritt Erickson, two credible resident citizens of said County, to me well known, who being duly sworn, depose and say that Lars Nilson the person first above named in this affidavit, has actually settled upon and cultivated as a Homestead, the land surveyed for him on the 28th day of January 1877, by the Surveyor aforesaid, for the period of three years, and they nor either of them have any interest in the said land.
