GENERAL LAND OFFICE.

Austin, Texas, Sept 1st 1880.

This is to certify that I find 28 acres of vacant public domain lying between the Joel Spencer and Susannah McKelvey surveys as follows:- The Susannah McKelvey survey calls to begin at the S.E. corner of M Rivers survey and thence S 60° W 8212 rods a corner live oaks marked N and Z, giving course and distance I found stumps corresponding to said calls and an old stone corner pointed out to me as the original N.W. corner of said McKelvey survey. In running out the McKelvey north line I pass the S.W. corner of M Rivers S.W. corner of Jacob Gross and S.W. corner of Charles Walden. The two former calling for bearing trees which were found on the ground, except two.

The N.E. corner of Joel Spencer and the N.W. corner of Charles A. Barton are the same. Barton's west line is 1344 rods and Walden's west line 672 making

2016 vros, while Spencers east line is only 1900 a difference of 116 vros the same as called for in fieldnote here presented. Joel Spencers S.E. corner calls for a Sycamore and a Pecan but they are both destroyed but old corner and stump found. Waldens S.W. corner simply calls for a mound of rocks which were found. Sarah Ann Iros survey passes Susannah McKelvey's survey running North 100 vros and really crosses Joel Spencers a short distance, hence there is a vacancy of 116 x 1366 vs lying inside of the bounds described in said field notes. Bosque county Texas on the waters of Steels
Creek about 8½ miles N. of Meadwell and
described as follows:-

Beginning at the S.E. corner of Joel
Spencer's survey for the N.E. corner of this
tract from which a Symamore mkt'd I
bears S 10° E 46 varas and a Pecon mkt'd P
bears S 7° E 51 varas; Thence S 30° E with the
west line of Charles Walden 116 varas to said
Walden's S.W. corner a mound of rocks in
Susanah McKilroy's north line; Thence S
60° W with McKilroy line 1366 varas to the
N.W. corner of said Susanah McKilroy's
survey a pile of rocks from which a Live
Oak mkt'd N bears N 30° E 109 varas and another
mkt'd V bears N 37° E 105 varas; Thence N 30° W
with Sarah Ann Peos east line 116 varas to
a pile of rocks in Joel Spencer's line from
which a Live Oak mkt'd Z bears N 15° W 42
varas (Here I find Sarah Ann Peos runs over the
Spencer line a few varas) Thence N 60° E
1366 varas to the beginning.

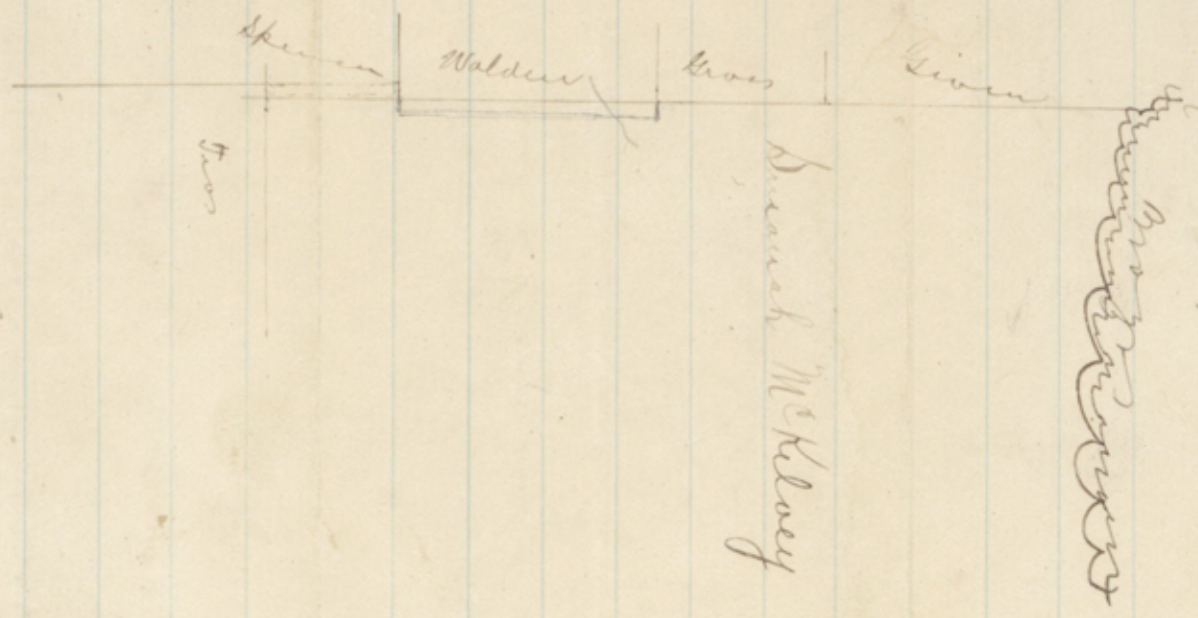
