

I herewith hand you plot and


field notes of actual Survey made on the grounds of a part of the Geo Rogers Preemption. When C. J. Blackwell got a patent on the Stephen Williams Survey he cut out 50 acres from the west end of the Geo Rogers to supplement his 640 warrant. The transfer which you have from Blackwell is only for a part of the Geo Rogers i.e. for that part only which he did not include in his Stephen Williams Patent. The field notes of the Rodin & Crane & Labor Survey & the Joe Doctor evidently make the S.E. corner of the former - the N.W. corner of the latter as you will observe from Plot tho it is not so indicated on the map of Boone Co.

The field notes make the S. line of the R.C. Crane (West Branch) 2222 rods - Blackwells Patent cuts off 350 rods from this line leaving 1872 rods. The S. line of the Crane is really 2406 rods from corner to corner but I have retained this as a standard the assumed run. The Stephen Williams Patent gives its most extreme Eastern cut 366 rods between S. W. Petty & R.C. Crane - thus we retain in your field notes of Geo Rogers. According to statement made in Maj. Walsh's Com. to you the N. line of J. W. Petty is 929 rods, so we run a line at 60° E 579 rods from a point which is 350 rods. at 60° E from S. W. corner of Petty - as the distance between the S. W. corner & the

Concerning your Statement in May. Walsh's Letter to
you is 321 275 - it must be 4000 from Mr. W. Co. &
of Petty to A. W. Co. as a James which was sur-
veyed according to. as the Compt of the Land
depart. suggests to you in one of his letters,
let the Land be Patented to A. J. Blackwell -
He is universally considered an unscrupulous
man - but he can take no advantage of
you with the evidences of ownership you have
on record - When I was Chf. Eng. of the
Atchison Santa Fe & C Rd, I procured hun-
dreds of Patents but am not acquainted with
the Law in Texas & have no Code at hand by
which to inform myself. If May. W. will
patent upon such evidence as he has ask him
to send the Patent to J. H. Robinson who
is known all over the State & I will pay for
you whatever fees may be due - If you are in
a hurry, and of course you are, and you cannot
get a patent ask May. Walsh to furnish you
a set of field notes that he will Patent & I
will Survey the Land for you - I understand that
the new Co. Surveyor is a perfect doct had
nothing no - experience as a Surveyor but you can
get him to correct the field notes as filed
& approve the work if necessary - as to charges
you owe me nothing - Hope you and your mother
may spend many sunny days upon the prairie

If you will refer to G. L. McLin's
Com. to May Walsh enclosing my Commu-
nication to McLin with Plots of all
the surrounding Surveys I think you
will notice that there is no conflict
between the remnant of the J. M. Rogers

was patented to G. H. Blackwell on a
transfer from Stephen Harris. The J. M.
Rogers was also trans. to Blackwell who
cut out some of it in order
to supplement the Stephen Williams -
