The State of Texas, $\frac{3}{3}$ Fieldnotes of a survey of
County of Bosque, $\frac{3}{3}$ 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres of land made
for James M. Robertson under and by virtue
of his application bearing date October
25th A.D. 1882; said application having been
made under and by virtue of Chapter 52
Sections 1 to 11 inclusive of both, of the
laws of the Special Session of the sixteenth
Legislature of the State of Texas, approved
July 14th A.D. 1879. Said survey is situated
about 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ miles S $60^{\circ}W$ from Meridian in
Bosque County Texas and bounded as follows,
to wit:-

Beginning at the N.E. corner of a survey
in the name of John Richardson for the N.W.
corner of this survey from which a Live Oak
mks T bears N $75^{\circ}W$ 20 rods and another
mks Y bears S $35^{\circ}E$ 51 rods; thence S $35^{\circ}E$
1340 rods crossed a ravine, 1640 rods crossed
a large branch, 1900 rods a pile of rocks
being the S.E. corner of said Richardson
survey from which an Elm mks R bears
N $80^{\circ}W$ 32 $\frac{1}{2}$ rods, and a Live Oak mks
T bears N $28^{\circ}W$ 130 rods; thence N $60^{\circ}E$
with George Harpers north line, 210 rods to
a pile of rocks in George Harpers north line
and Seaborn Harris west line; thence
N $30^{\circ}W$ with said Harris west line,
660 rods crossed a large branch, 1470
rods passed Seaborn Harris N.W. corner,
1900 rods a pile of rocks in Samuel
Shirleys south line being T. F. Ram-
peys N.W. corner; thence S $60^{\circ}W$ with

said Shirley south line 210 mrs to the
place of beginning.

By virtue of Chapter 52 Sections 1 to 11 inclusive of both, of the Laws of the extra session of the 16th Legislature of the State of Texas, pages 48 and 49, I hereby make application for a survey of all of the vacant and unappropriated lands lying and being in Bosque Co Texas on the waters of Spring Creek about 7 miles S.E. from Meridim, the same being 75 acres more or less as follows:-
