The State of Texas, } Fieldnotes of a survey of
County of Bosque, } 70 1/2 acres of land made
for James M. Robertson under and by virtue
of his application bearing date October
25th A.D. 1882; said application having been
made under and by virtue of Chapter 52
Sections 1 to 11 inclusive of both, of the
Laws of the Special Session of the sixteenth
Legislature of the State of Texas, approved
July 14th A.D. 1879. Said survey is situated ^{on the waters of Spring Creek} situated
about 6 1/2 miles S 60° W from Meridian in
Bosque County Texas and bounded as follows,
to wit: -

Beginning at the N.E. corner of a survey
in the name of John Richardson for the N.W.
corner of this survey from which a Live Oak
mkd J bears N 75° W 20000 and another
mkd Y bears S 35° E 51000; Thence S 30° E
13400 vns crossed a ravine, 16400 vns crossed
a large branch, 19000 vns a pile of rocks
being the S.E. corner of said Richardson
survey from which an Elm mkd R bears
N 80 1/2° W 32 1/2 vns, and a Live Oak mkd
J bears N 28 1/2° W 130 vns; Thence N 60° E
with Geo W Harpers North line, 210 vns to
a pile of rocks in Geo W Harpers North line
and Seaborn Harris west line; Thence
N 30° W with said Harris west line,
660 vns crossed a large branch, 1470
vns passed Seaborn Harris N.W. corner,
1900 vns a pile of rocks in Samuel
Shirley's South line being T. F. Ram-
peys N.W. corner; Thence S 60° W with

said Shirley's south line 210 rods to the
place of beginning.

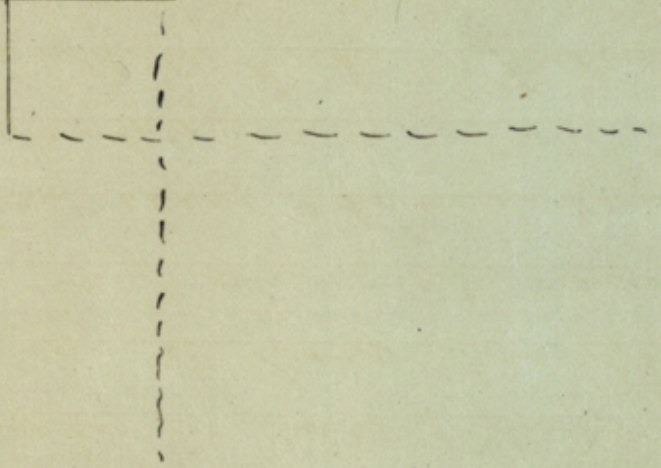
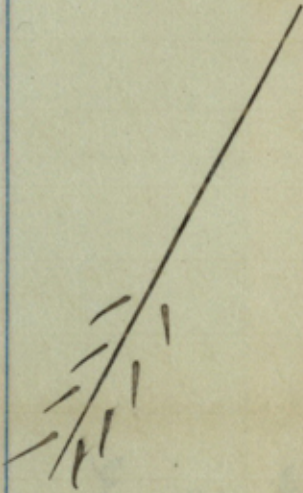

session of the 16th Legislature of the State of
Texas, pages 48 and 49, I hereby make application
for a survey of all of the vacant and unappropri-
ated lands lying and being in Bosque Co

7 miles S^W from Meridion, the same being
75 acres more or less as follows:-
