

Report of the Surveyor on the
Geo of Stowell Survey & Bogue Co.
N.Y.

I located the S.W. Cr. of the James Stake
league from the N.W. Cr. of the Wm Fisher
Survey at which corner one of the original
witness trees is still standing & corresponds
within 13 ws. of the call for Darrington's
Crk, now Stake Crk. From this Cor ran
S 60° W. the complement of the S. line Stake
league in corner 160 or S $30^{\circ}E$ & 43 ws. N $60^{\circ}E$.
from the N.E. Cr. of the E.M. Goulden which
corner is defined by one of the original
witness trees still standing. In Stetch,
I found the west end of the S. line of the
Wm Williams anciently marked & so ran
the west line of the Stake league N $30^{\circ}W$
2649 rs. to intersect this line (or 2489 rs.
from N.E. Cr. Goulden)

I put in the S.W. Cr. of the Wm Williams
from its own Natural field calls 393 rs.
S $60^{\circ}W$ from the only branch on this line
or 545 S $60^{\circ}W$ from N.W. Cr. Stake League.
The distance given in the call for the
N. line of the Stake is evidently a mistake
as to run it as called for destroys all
the relations with the Bowen, Rufus Charles
& the Natural Crk calls open the N.E. Cr. of
the Stake league in Hill Co. by 662 rs. actual
run - It is more than likely that the 43 rs. I made
between the Stake & Goulden belongs to Stake
league really closer with the Goulden.

I found the Palmer E. line 1000 m. instead of 950
witness trees at foot N.E. & N.W. cor. still standing
I threw in S. line also but not bounded as
called for hence I put in new trees -

Found all the witness trees on the 3 preemption
surveys in this sketch but some of them
so badly burnt & decayed as to require new ones
hence they were put in.

I found the S.E. cor. of the Thompson preempt.
Surv. and its witness standing but 72 m. E.
of its true position can conflict with the
Loney preempt. which accounts for the
shortening of 2 lines in the Survey of Alwell
field Culls -

The distance from the S.W. cor. of the Palmer to
McMeens' East line makes a great excess for
the Goulden but this excess is clearly made
by running from N.E. cor. Goulden (witness still
standing) to the old marked line between the
Garrett Allen & E.R. Goulden each of them
having actually about the same excess East &
West.

There is much controversy about the true position
of the N.E. cor. of the Garrett Allen. The S.E. cor.
of the Garrett Allen is well settled, so observing
that the Penfshafer & Allen are tied by their
mutual field notes & that the Allen (N.E.) is 1450
m. longer than the same combined lines of
said Penfshafer & R. Goulden I put the N.E. cor.
of said Allen 1450 N 30° W of N. line Goulden -


