Ballier Clerk of the County Court of Bosque County, this day personally appeared Jacob Ellingson to me known, who after being by me duly sworn, upon his oath deposes and says: that he is now a bona fide settler upon Eighty acres of Land, that he believes to be of the public vacant lands of the State of Texas, that he is improving said land for a Homestead, and has no other; and further that he is a single man and makes this Affidavit for the purpose of obtaining a Home. Said Land is situated in Bosque County, about 1 1/2 miles "D" from Meridian, on the waters of Meridian Creek: beginning on the "N" line of the Key Kendall survey and more particularly described by the accompanying field notes.



PROOF OF SETTLEMENT UNDER HOMESTEAD ACT.

The State of Texas,
County of Bosque }

BEFORE ME, the undersigned, County Clerk in and for the County aforesaid, this day came and personally appeared Jacob Ellison, a resident citizen of said County, who being by me duly sworn, declares that he is a *bina fide* settler upon 80 acres of vacant Public Land, situated in said County, and surveyed for him on the 30^a day of January 1879, by Jas M Robertson a Surveyor of said County; that he has occupied and improved the same as a Homestead for a period of three consecutive years, beginning on the 16^a day of December 1878, that he is a single man, and that he makes this affidavit for the purpose of obtaining a title to the same for a Homestead, under "An act for the Benefit of Actual Occupants of the Public Lands," approved May 26th, 1873, and Acts prior thereto; and that he has not a Homestead other than the above.

And also at the same time came and personally appeared Ole Johnson and Andrew Peterson, two credible resident citizens of said County, to me well known, who being duly sworn, depose and say that Jacob Ellison, the person first above named in this Affidavit, has actually settled upon and cultivated as a Homestead the land surveyed for him on the 30^a day of January 1879, by the surveyor aforesaid, for the period of three years, and they nor either of them have any interest in the said land.
