The State of Texas ^{comprised} Field notes of a survey of 160
County of Bosque acres of land made for H. L.
Frank by virtue of his certificate of occupancy
issued by the County Clerk of Bosque county
on the 2nd day of February A.D. 1871 said land
being situated in Bosque county Texas ~~and situate~~
^{North 80°}
on the waters of the Bosque River 10 miles west
of Wundion.

Beginning at the N.W. corner of Wm Van
Hornum's survey a pile of rocks from which
a Pine oak marked Z bears S 9° E
200 vases. Thence S 30 E 525 vases a branch 750
vases to a pile of rocks on top of mountain
no bearings convenient; Thence S 60 W 950 vases
to a pile of rocks for the S.W. corner in moun-
tain prairie; Thence N 30 W 750 vases top of bluff
950 to a pile of rocks in south line of Wm
McHarlow's survey from which a large rock
marked X bears S 34½ E 104 vases; Thence S 65
E 950 vases to beginning.

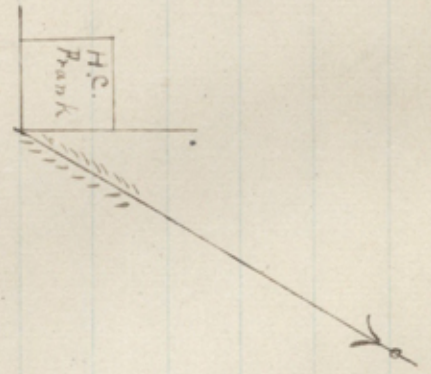

settler upon 160 acres of vacant public land, situated in said County, and
surveyed for W. C. Frank on the 22 day of
April 1879 by J. M. Robertson a Surveyor of
said County; that he has occupied and improved the same as a Homestead for a period of
three consecutive years, beginning on the 15th day of January 1878
that he is a Married man and that he makes affidavit for the
purpose of obtaining a title to the same for a Homestead, under an Act supplementary to
"An Act for the Benefit of Actual Occupants of the Public Lands," approved May 26th,
1873, and Acts prior thereto; and that he has not a Homestead other than the above.

AND also at the same time came and personally appeared D. M. Frank
and J. B. Frank two credible resident citizens of said County, to me
well known, who being duly sworn, depose and say that W. C. Frank
the person first above named in this Affidavit; has actually settled upon and cultivated as a
Homestead, the land surveyed for him on the 22 day of April 1879
by the Surveyor aforesaid, for the period of three years, and they nor either of them have
any interest in the said land.
