 to be 2 distinct South lines run by Surveyors  
 for the S. line of the Jose Cordova Jr. Survey  
 103<sup>00</sup> apart. The Rainbolt ~~was~~ S. E. Co. was  
 made with reference to the upper line &  
 the Chester from the more Southern line.  
 The more Southern line in the true one &  
 upon this bases there is no conflict upon  
 the ground. as it makes the Rainbolt begin  
 200<sup>00</sup> N 30° W from the true S. W. Co. Jose  
 Cordova Survey-

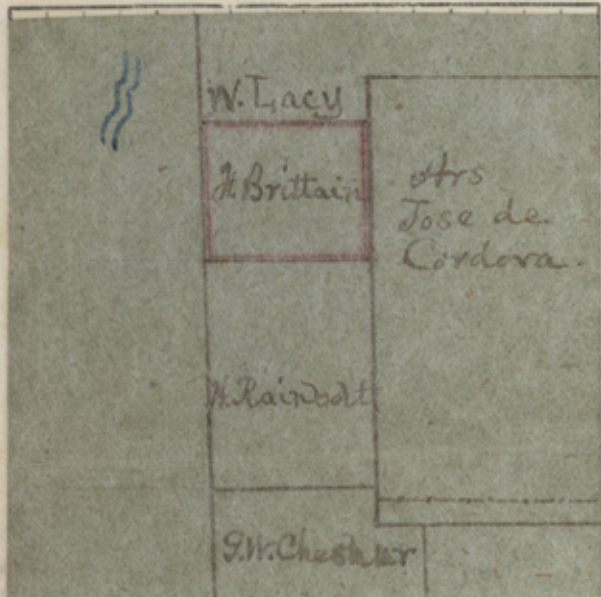


