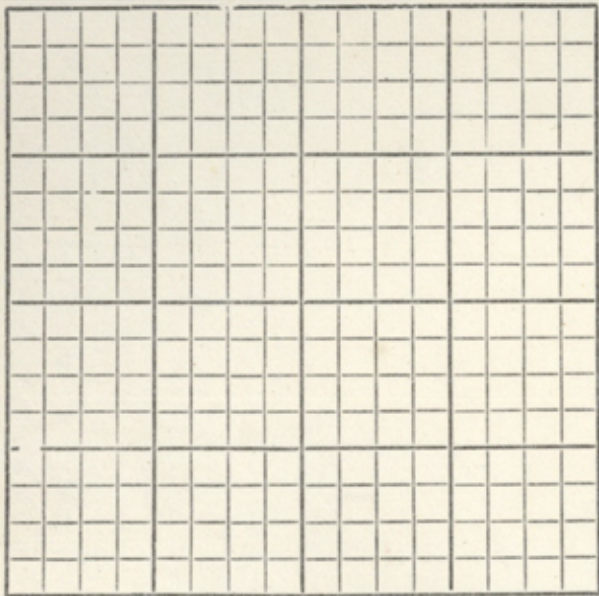

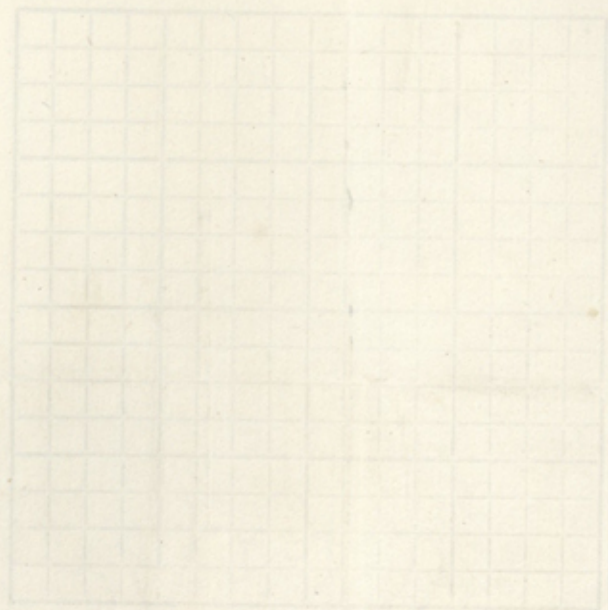

Report on Survey to establish
 the vacancy between the G.W. Couch
 & Jas H Smith 1 labor survey.

I found by actual survey on the ground
 that the distance from N.W. Co. of the
 Wm Parvin survey (Witness tree called for at
 this corner ~~being~~ still standing) is & the
 S.W. Co. Jas H Smith, which is S.E. Co. of
 the Geo. Bond (a corner settled by judicial
 decision in Bosque) is 1788⁰⁰. Also by
 survey conducted by J.N. Wells for the G.W.
 Couch - that the distance from N.W. Co.
 Wm Parvin to S.W. Co. said Couch must be
 $1440 - 670^{00} = 770^{00}$ which leaves for said
 vacancy 249⁰⁰. The above survey is
 absolutely correct provided the G.W. Couch
 is properly located but it is impossible to
 locate the upper Wm L Kidd so as to make the
 S.W. Co. at a point S 60° W - 400⁰⁰ & N 30° W - 180⁰⁰
 from the N.W. Co. of another Wm L Kidd, but the
 same time make said S.W. Co. upper Kidd conform
 to the Couch call. This Co. however has been established
 by general consent for many years - H.M. Dillard Co. Surveyor, Bosque
