on the ground the above described  
lands follows: -

I went to the S.W. cor. of  
G.O. Peterson where one bearing still  
standing & other stumps preserved.

Thence ~~N 30° E~~ and at 640 vrs.  
crossed the E line of the Peder Pederson  
Ac. emption. I then began here for  
Hanson's survey. Th. N 30° E at 310 vrs  
ran over G.O. Petersons E. cor.: Th. S 30° E  
at 540 vrs ran up to Wm Hall's fence.  
The W line of this fence has S 30° E  
and runs to E.W. cor. of sec. 706  
instead of its own NW. corner,  
and at 580 vrs. ran to D.P.P.C. Nel-  
son's W.E. cor., where living witnesses  
saw it put. Th. S 60° W 310 to Peder  
Pederson's E. cor. Th. N 30° W 380  
to place of Peg.
