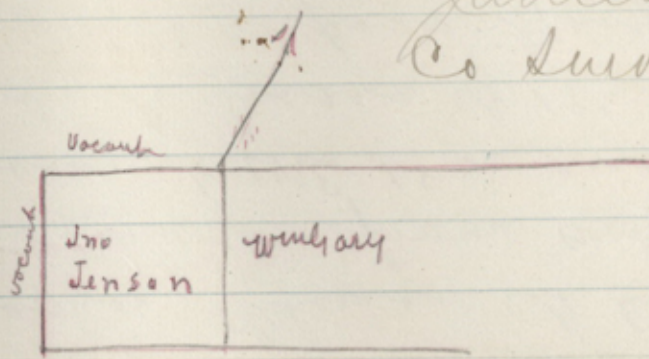

Proof of Settlement under Homestead Act.

The State of Texas,
County of Brewster

Before me, the undersigned John J. Garrison Clerk in and for the County aforesaid, this day came and personally appeared John Garrison a resident citizen of said County, who being by me duly sworn, declares that he is a bona fide settler upon 100 acres of vacant public land, situated in said County, and surveyed for John Garrison on the 1 day of April 1880 by J. M. Robertson a Surveyor of said County; that he has occupied and improved the same as a Homestead for a period of three consecutive years, beginning on the 1 day of April 1877 that he is single and that he makes affidavit for the purpose of obtaining a title to the same for a Homestead, under an Act supplementary to "An Act for the Benefit of Actual Occupants of the Public Lands," approved May 26th, 1873, and Acts prior thereto; and that he has not a Homestead other than the above.

AND also at the same time came and personally appeared John Garrison and A. Seeger two credible resident citizens of said County, to me well known, who being duly sworn, depose and say that John Garrison the person first above named in this Affidavit; has actually settled upon and cultivated as a Homestead, the land surveyed for him on the 1 day of April 1880 by the Surveyor aforesaid, for the period of three years, and they nor either of them have any interest in the said land.
