in Bosque County Texas.

Beginning at the S. W. corner of
Jasper & Everett's survey a pile of
rocks for the beginning corner of this survey
Then N. 43° W 950 rods to J. & Everett's
N. W. corner a pile of rocks for E.
corner of this survey. Thence S 60° W
with Jeremiah Whitworth south
line 580 rods to a pile of rocks at
the foot of the mountain,
Thence S 30° E with Whitworth's
line 1000 rods to a pile of rocks;
being Whitworth's intermediate
corner. Thence N 60° E with
Whitworth's line 580 rods to a
pile of rocks being Whitworth's
intermediate N. E. corner. Then
N 30° W 50 rods to the beginning

AFFIDAVIT FOR PRE-EMPTION.

THE STATE OF TEXAS,

COUNTY OF BOSQUE.

Before me, John H. Johnson, Clerk of the District Court of Bosque County, this day personally appeared B. F. Cooper, to me known, who after being by me duly sworn, upon his oath deposes and says: that he is now a bona fide settler upon One Hundred and Sixty acres of Land, that he believes to be of the public vacant lands of the State of Texas; that he is improving said land for a Homestead, and has no other; and further that he is a Married man and makes this Affidavit for the purpose of obtaining a Home. Said Land is situated in Bosque County, about 6 miles South from Meridian, on the waters of Bosque River Creek: beginning at the South West Corner of the Jasper N. Everett Survey, and more particularly described by the accompanying field notes.
