AFFIDAVIT FOR PRE-EMPTION.

THE STATE OF TEXAS,

COUNTY OF BOSQUE.

Before me, John H. Johnson, Clerk of the District Court of Bosque County, this day personally appeared Mrs. Penecy C. Jameson, to me known, who after being by me duly sworn, upon ~~his~~ ^{her} oath deposes and says: that she is now a bona fide settler upon one hundred ^{more or less} acres of Land, that she believes to be of the public vacant lands of the State of Texas; that she is improving said land for a Homestead, and has no other; and further that she is a widow ^{woman, & the head of a family} and makes this Affidavit for the purpose of obtaining a Home. Said Land is situated in Bosque County, about 6 miles S.E., from Meridian, on the waters of the Bosque Creek: River, beginning at the S.E. Corner of R. K. P. Sandefur Survey,

and more particularly described by the accompanying field notes.

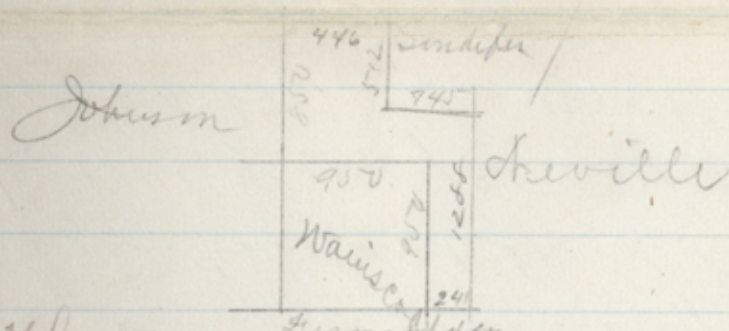

Proof of Settlement under Homestead Act.

Before me, the undersigned John H. Johnson Clerk in and for the County aforesaid, this day came and personally appeared Mrs P. C. Jimerson a resident citizen of said County, who being by me duly sworn, declares that she is a bona fide settler upon (160) acres of vacant public land, situated in said County, and surveyed for Mrs P. C. Jimerson on the 20th day of November 1880 by James M. Robertson a Surveyor of said County; that she has occupied and improved the same as a Homestead for a period of three consecutive years, beginning on the 17th day of April 1879 that she is a Widow, and that she makes affidavit for the purpose of obtaining a title to the same for a Homestead, under an Act supplementary to "An Act for the Benefit of Actual Occupants of the Public Lands," approved May 26th, 1873, and Acts prior thereto; and that she has not a Homestead other than the above.

AND also at the same time came and personally appeared R. K. B. Sandefer and W. H. Shaw two credible resident citizens of said County, to me well known, who being duly sworn, depose and say that Mrs P. C. Jimerson the person first above named in this Affidavit; has actually settled upon and cultivated as a Homestead, the land surveyed for ^{her} him on the 20th day of November 1880 by the Surveyor aforesaid, for the period of three years, and they nor either of them have any interest in the said land.
