vit of settlement made before the Co
Clerk of Bosque County Texas on
the 17th day of April AD 1850.

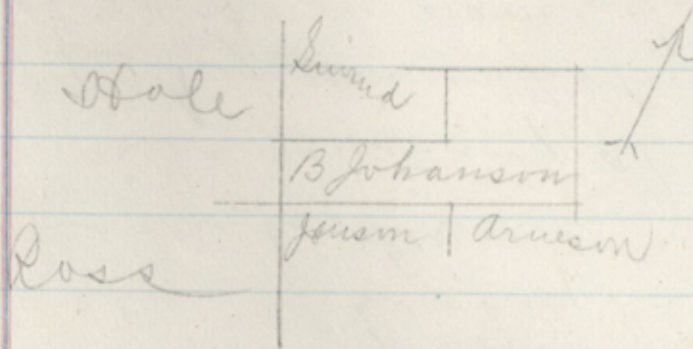
Said survey is situated about 12
miles south ^{25⁰⁰} of Meridian on the
waters of Turkey Creek in Bosque
County Texas.

Beginning at the S.W. corner
of A. Jensen's patented survey a pile
of rocks in David T. Ross east line
from which a Live Oak S bears
at 46 E 12 rods; Thence at 30 N 37 1/2
rods to a pile of rocks being Ole Sinner's
S.W. corner from which a Live Oak mk'd
bears S 12 W 58 rods and another X bears
S 22 1/2 E 60 rods; Thence at 60 E 66 1/2
rods a branch 950 rods to Sinner's S.E.
corner a pile of rocks from which a
Live Oak mk'd bears at 63 1/2 W 23 rods
and another mk'd Y bears at 49 W
41 rods; Thence at 30 W 366 rods to a
pile of rocks in Sinner's east line;
Thence at 60 E 740 rods a pile of rocks
on the mountain; Thence S 30 E 740
rods to a pile of rocks in P. Arneson's
North line; Thence S 60 W 1690 rods to
beginning.

and surveyed for Brent Johnson on the 13th day of

October 1880 by J. M. Robertson a Surveyor of

said County, ; that he has occupied and improved the same as a Homestead for a period of

three consecutive years, beginning on the 1 day of April 1880

that he is Married Man and that he makes this affidavit for the

purpose of obtaining a title to the same for a Homestead, under an Act supplementary to

"An Act for the Benefit of Actual Occupants of the Public Lands," approved May 26th,

1873, and Acts prior thereto; and that he has not a Homestead other than the above.

AND also at the same time came and personally appeared E. Johnson

and P. Amesen two credible resident citizens of said County, to me

well known, who being duly sworn, depose and say that Brent Johnson

the person first above named in this Affidavit, has actually settled upon and cultivated as a

Homestead, the land surveyed for him on the 13th day of October 1880

by the Surveyor aforesaid, for the period of three years, and they nor either of them have

any interest in the said land.
