and more particularly described by the accompanying field notes.

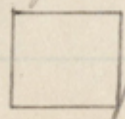

PROOF OF SETTLEMENT UNDER HOMESTEAD ACT.

The State of Texas, }
County of Bosque

BEFORE ME, the undersigned, County Clerk in and for the County aforesaid, this day came and personally appeared G. Nelson, a resident citizen of said County, who being by me duly sworn, declares that he is a bona fide settler upon 80 acres of vacant Public Land, situated in said County, and surveyed for him on the 28th day of April 1884, by P. Piersen Dpt Co Sur a Surveyor of said County; that he has occupied and improved the same as a Homestead for a period of three consecutive years, beginning on the 15th day of Sept 1880, that he is Single man, and that he makes this affidavit for the purpose of obtaining a title to the same for a Homestead, under "An act for the Benefit of Actual Occupants of the Public Lands," approved May 26th, 1873, and Acts prior thereto; and that he has not a Homestead other than the above.

And also at the same time came and personally appeared N Porstie and M P Ruison, two credible resident citizens of said County, to me well known, who being duly sworn, depose and say that G Nelson the person first above named in this Affidavit, has actually settled upon and cultivated as a Homestead the land surveyed for him on the 27th day of April 1884, by the surveyor aforesaid, for the period of three years, and they nor either of them have any interest in the said land.
