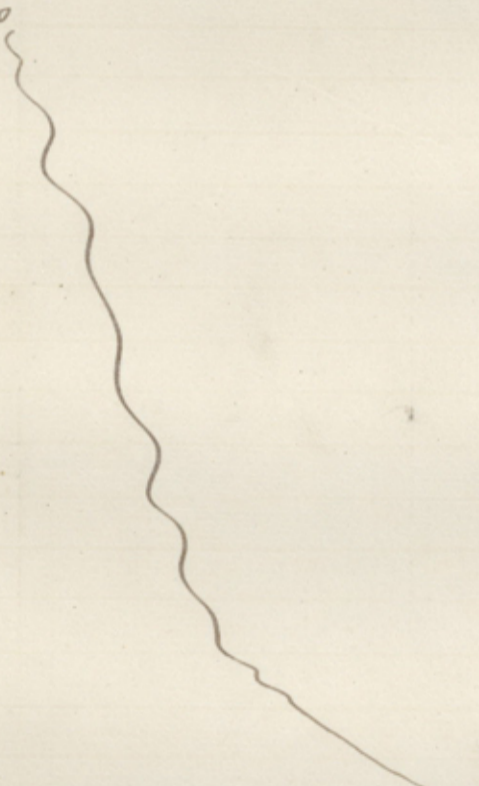

Proof of Settlement under Homestead Act.

Before me, the undersigned District Clerk in and for the County aforesaid, this day came and personally appeared S. B. Cranfill a resident citizen of ^{Hamilton} said County, who being by me duly sworn, declares that he is a bona fide settler upon (160) acres of vacant public land, situated in said County, and surveyed for S. B. Cranfill on the 4th day of April 1881 by W. T. Bayon a Surveyor of ^{Hamilton} said County; that he has occupied and improved the same as a Homestead for a period of three consecutive years, beginning on the 4th day of January 1878 that he is a Married man and that he makes affidavit for the purpose of obtaining a title to the same for a Homestead, under an Act supplementary to "An Act for the Benefit of Actual Occupants of the Public Lands," approved May 26th, 1873, and Acts prior thereto; and that he has not a Homestead other than the above.

AND also at the same time came and personally appeared W. M. Smith and S. C. Pettus two credible resident citizens of said County, to me well known, who being duly sworn, depose and say that S. B.
