a Surveyor of said County; that he has occupied and improved the same as a Homestead for a period of three consecutive years, beginning on the 10th day of Dec 1880, that he ~~was at~~

the state of application a single man but now a married man and that he makes this affidavit for the purpose of obtaining a title to the same for a Homestead, under "An act for the Benefit of Actual Occupants of the Public Lands," approved May 26th, 1873, and Acts prior thereto; and that he has not a Homestead other than the above.

And also at the same time came and personally appeared Ole Aunburg and M P Rierson, two credible resident citizens of said County, to me well known, who being duly sworn, depose and say that John Rogstad
