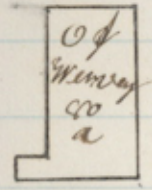

Werneen, a resident citizen of said County, who being by me duly sworn, declares that he is a *bona fide* settler upon Eighty acres of vacant Public Land, situated in said County, and surveyed for him on the 1st day of April 1881, by D. J. Brodhead a Surveyor of said County; that he has occupied and improved the same as a Homestead for a period of three consecutive years, beginning on the 1st day of April 1881, that he is _____, and that he makes this affidavit for the purpose of obtaining a title to the same for a Homestead, under "An act for the Benefit of Actual Occupants of the Public Lands," approved May 26th, 1873, and Acts prior thereto; and that he has not a Homestead other than the above.

And also at the same time came and personally appeared A. Jansen and A. Christofferson, two credible resident citizens of said County, to me well known, who being duly sworn, depose and say that O. J. 
