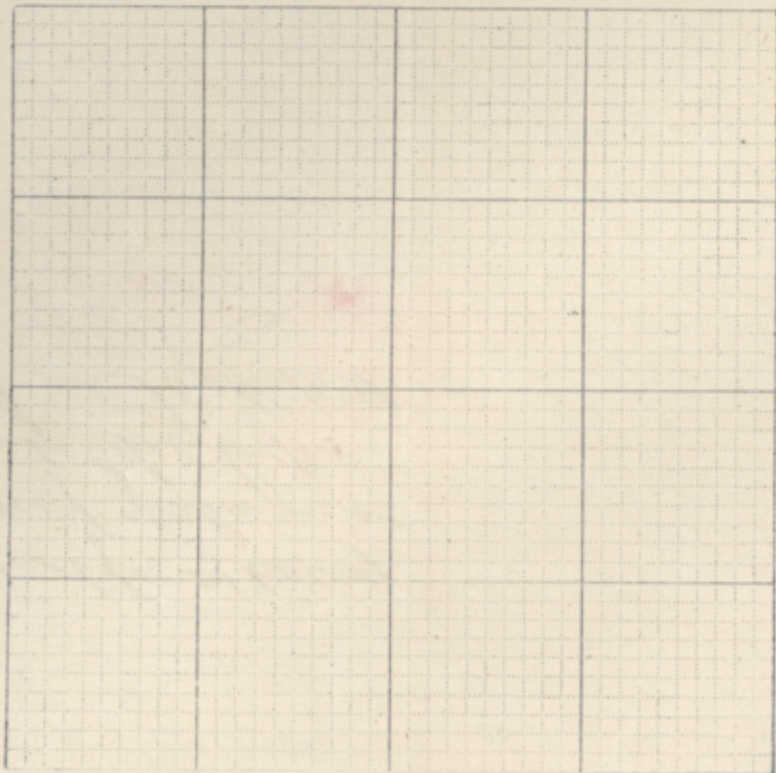

## Proof of Settlement under Homestead Act.

Before me, the undersigned H. C. Cooke Clerk in and for the County aforesaid, this day came and personally appeared J. N. Weeks a resident citizen of said County, who being by me duly sworn, declares that he is a bona fide settler upon 160 acres of vacant public land, situated in said County, and surveyed for J. N. Weeks on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of May 1881 by S. J. Siddall a Surveyor of said County; that he has occupied and improved the same as a Homestead for a period of three consecutive years, beginning on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of June 1881 that he is a married man and that he makes affidavit for the purpose of obtaining a title to the same for a Homestead, under an Act supplementary to "An Act for the Benefit of Actual Occupants of the Public Lands," approved May 26th, 1873, and Acts prior thereto; and that he has not a Homestead other than the above.

AND also at the same time came and personally appeared James Losebee and O. C. Pallard two credible resident citizens of said County, to me well known, who being duly sworn, depose and say that J. N. Weeks the person first above named in this Affidavit; has actually settled upon and cultivated as a Homestead, the land surveyed for him on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of May 1881 by the Surveyor aforesaid, for the period of three years, and they nor either of them have any interest in the said land.
