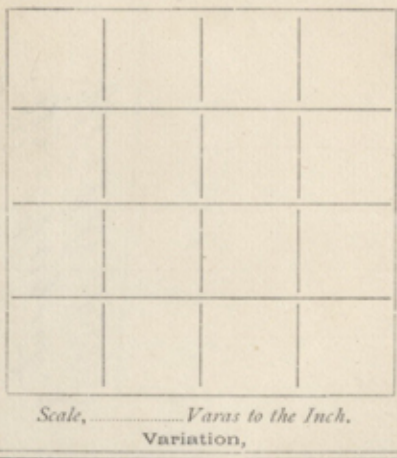

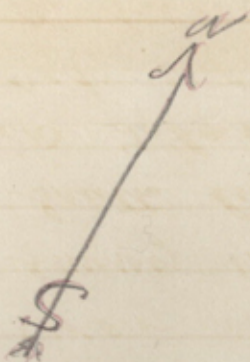

PROOF OF SETTLEMENT UNDER HOMESTEAD ACT.

The State of Texas,
County of Bosque

BEFORE ME, the undersigned, County Clerk in and for the County aforesaid, this day came and personally appeared Mrs. R. A. August, a resident citizen of said County, who being by me duly sworn, declares that she is a *bona fide* settler upon Eighty Four acres of vacant Public Land, situated in said County, and surveyed for R. August on the January day of 1883, by V. J. Siddall a Surveyor of said County; that he has occupied and improved the same as a Homestead for a period of three consecutive years, beginning on the First day of January 1883, that he is a widow her husband having died since filing on said land, and that she makes this affidavit for the purpose of obtaining a title to the same for a Homestead, under "An act for the Benefit of Actual Occupants of the Public Lands," approved May 26th, 1873, and Acts prior thereto; and that she has not a Homestead other than the above.

And also at the same time came and personally appeared W. R. King and G. W. Scott, two credible resident citizens of said County, to me well known, who being duly sworn, depose and say that Mrs. R. A. August the person first above named in this Affidavit, has actually settled upon and cultivated as a Homestead the land surveyed for him on the January day of 1883, by the surveyor aforesaid, for the period of three years, and they nor either of them have any interest in the said land.
