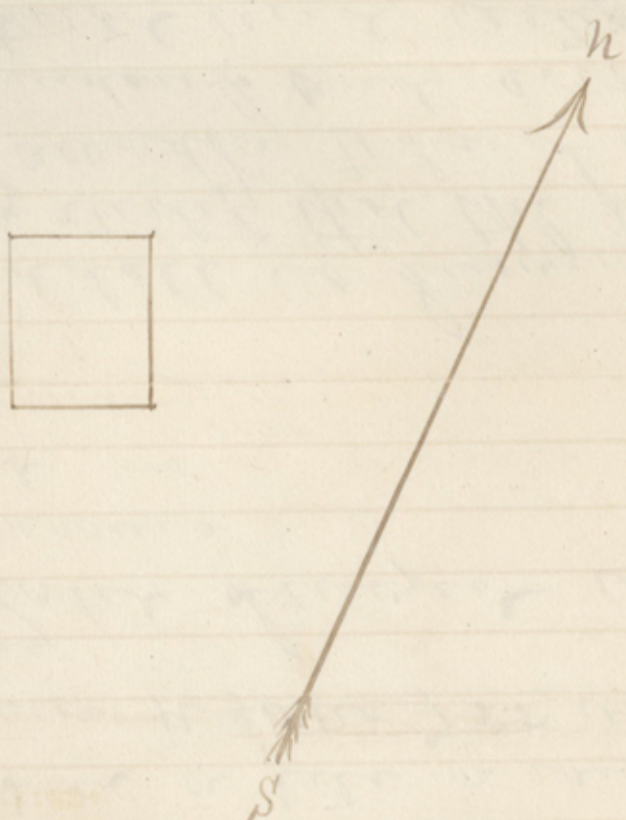

and make an actual survey of the 84 acres of land in the said County,
corrected field notes of which with application of the heirs of said
Z.Cranfill for a patent on said land, is now on file with the Commis-
sioner of the General Land Office of, Texas. That in making said sur-
vey and location, I did find the N.E. and S.E. corners of the S.B.Cran-
fill survey as recognized by the present owner, the vendee of S.B.Cran-
fill; that I found the N.E. corner of said S.B.Cranfill survey as so recog-
nized, to be 649-1/2 varas ~~XXXXXX~~ S.60 W. from the S.E. corner of the
J.Cornin 320 acre survey and the S.W. corner of the J.Cornin 640 acre
survey and the N.W. corner of the J.W.Schrimpf surveys as recognized
by the several owners of said surveys, which said corners I found on
the ground and recognized as such by said owners as aforesaid.

I also found the N.W. corner of the F.Renfro survey on the ground
as it is recognized, and it is in a course N.30 W. from the S.W. corner

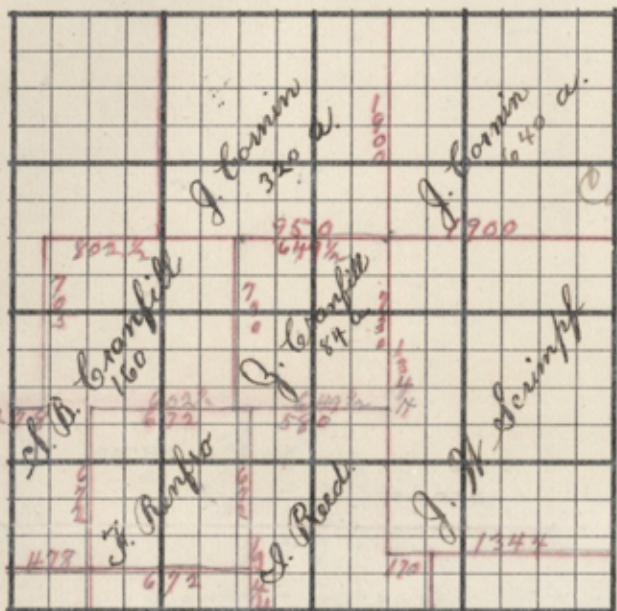
