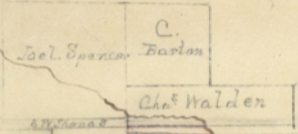

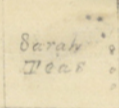

320 A. Survey for N.W. Cor. of this mound for  
Corner in prairie.

Thence N 60° E with said Walden line 1172<sup>00</sup>  
to Steele's Creek.

Thence with Steele's Creek on a base line N 63° 48'  
E - 124<sup>00</sup> vs. to S. E. Cor. <sup>on N. base 5. M. Stealey Survey</sup> from which line more  
landed O'Leary N 64° W - 7<sup>00</sup>.

Thence S 60° W with said McMilvey N. line  
1237<sup>00</sup> vs. to S.W. Cor. of this Survey on  
S. side of a branch in prairie, mound for corner.

Thence N 30° W - 110<sup>00</sup> vs. to beginning.

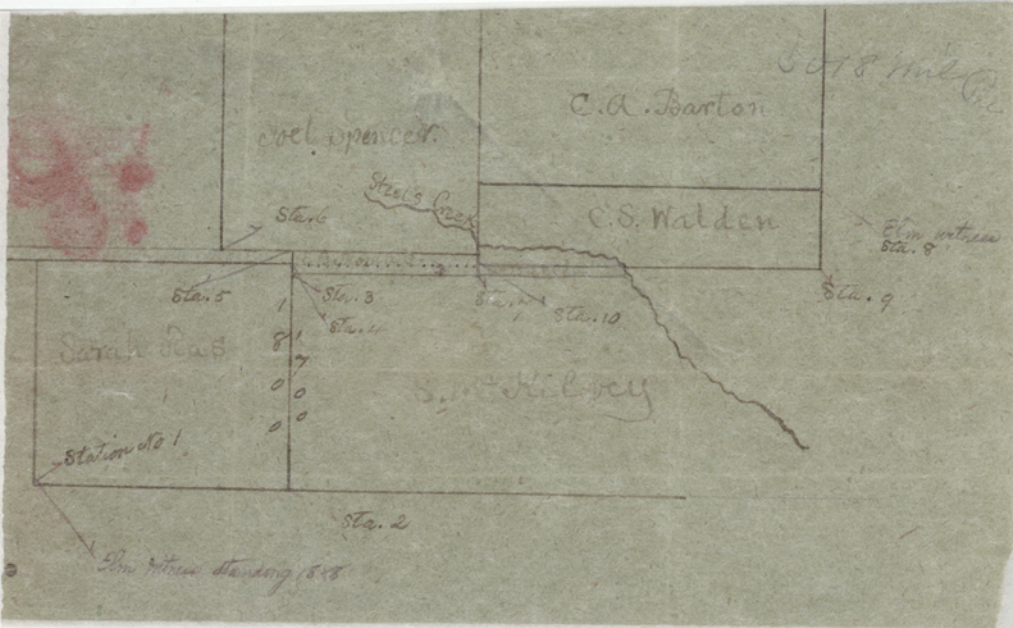

Sketch & Report of preemption Survey made  
for W. B. Allen on Steele's Creek 8 M. N.E. of  
Auridian Bosque Co. Tex. (See Certified Survey  
of said Allen homestead now on file in G. L. O.)

In locating & defining the boundaries of above  
named homestead survey for W. B. Allen, I commenced  
at the S.W. Cor. of the Sarah Feas Survey (See Sketch)  
at which the Elms called for in the field notes of  
the original survey, are now standing & of which  
there is no controversy. On west line of same & near  
said S.W. Cor. is an original fore & aft tree which  
gave me the variation of  $9^{\circ}48'3''$  (Randolph's transit)  
by which to run the line. From S.W. Cor. Feas  
ran  $N 60^{\circ} E$  to S.E. Cor. of same (marked Station No. 2)  
Th. ran  $N 30^{\circ} W$  1700 ors. as per field notes of the McKilvey  
for said McKilvey N.W. Cor. Sta. No. 3 - found pile  
of rock for corner (No witness called for) - thence  
with same course 100 ors. farther or 1800 ors. for the  
N.E. Cor. of the S. Feas (Sta. No. 4) - no witness trees  
standing, nor have been in the memory of the oldest  
citizens of that section. Having failed to reach the

I run of the Fred Spencer at this distance which is  
an old marked line, I continued  $N 30^{\circ} W.$  & at  
1926 <sup>Sta. 5</sup> rods. struck I. line of said Spencer & since  
ran  $S 60^{\circ} W.$  & on this line found the S.W. Cor.  
of said Spencer with Live O. banded O still stand-  
ing to define this corner - marked Sta. 6  
I thus established the fact that there actually  
exists from course & distance, with no connecting  
calls to close them, a space of 126 rods between  
the said Spencer & J. Sears.

From Sta. No. 3 which is N.W. Cor. of the McAlvey  
I ran  $N 60^{\circ} E.$  to a point  $S 30^{\circ} E.$  of the S.E. Cor.  
E.G. Thomas Sta. No. 7.

I then went to N.E. Cor. of the C. S. Walden  
(Sta. 8) at which is standing the Elm called  
for in original field notes. From this point  
ran  $S 30^{\circ} E.$  - dist. of said Walden (no witnesses  
standing) (open prairie country) (Sta. 9)

th.  $S 60^{\circ} W.$  crossing Crick and distance called for  
& got to Sta. 10. which is S.E. Cor. Thomas as called  
for by distance & S.W. Cor. Walden. No witness trees  
found but the corner is established & held fast  
by the Crick calls on West line Walden.

From Station 10 I ran  $S 30^{\circ} E.$  & at 111 rods. was at Sta.

7 - thus clearly showing that by course & distance  
with no connections to destroy the conditions of the  
Survey there must be a space of at least 110  
ms. as per field notes now on record both  
in Surveyors Records of Bogque & the G. & C.

I hereby certify that the above sketch

on the ground.
