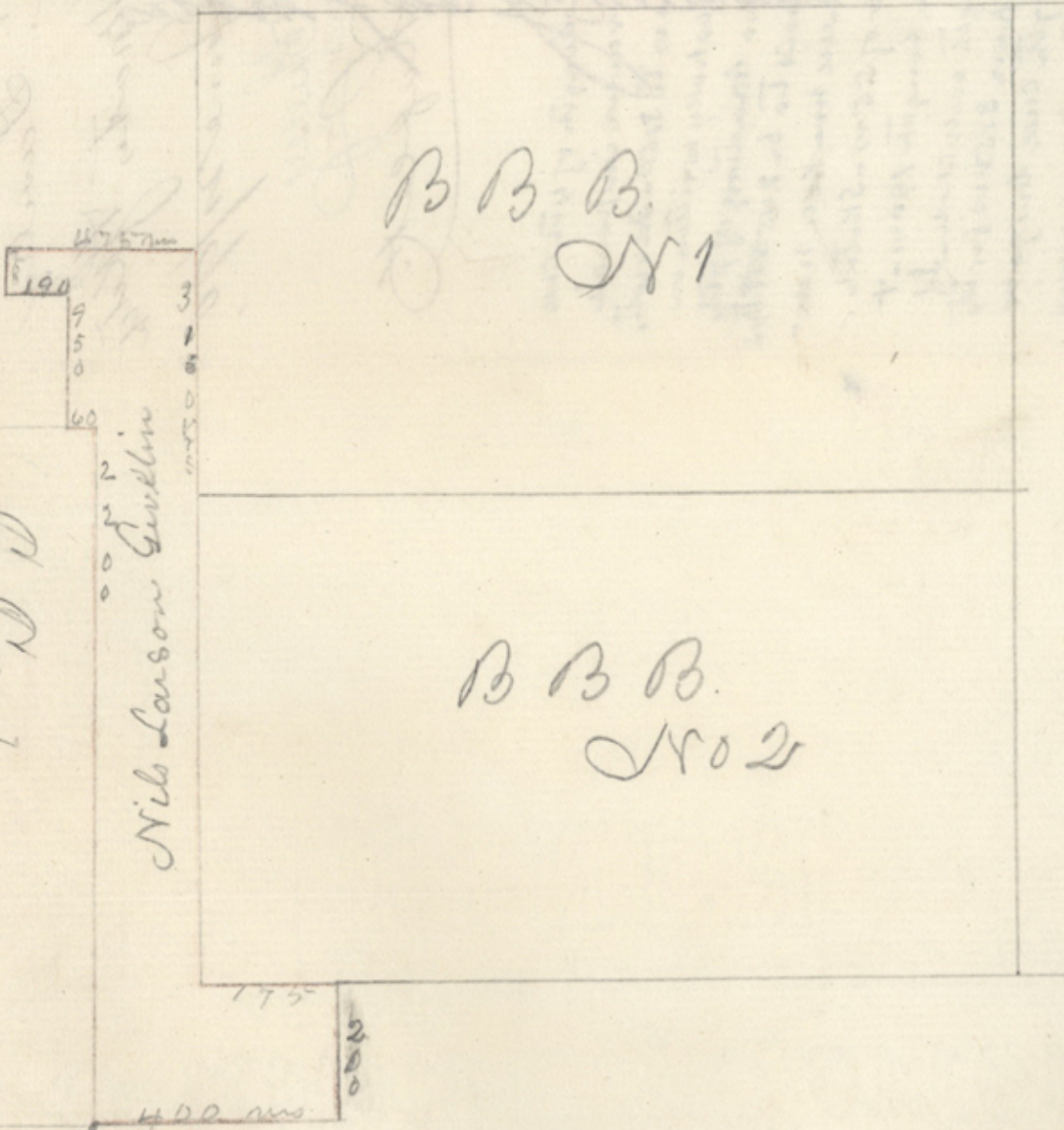

Before me, the undersigned County Clerk in and for the County aforesaid, this day came and personally appeared Nils Larsen Gureland a resident citizen of said County, who being by me duly sworn, declares that he is a bona fide settler upon 160 acres of vacant public land, situated in said County, and surveyed for him on the 23 day of May 1887 by J. N. Weeks a Surveyor of said County; that he has occupied and improved the same as a Homestead for a period of three consecutive years, beginning on the 17th day of May 1887 that he is a married man and that he makes affidavit for the purpose of obtaining a title to the same for a Homestead, under an Act supplementary to "An Act for the Benefit of Actual Occupants of the Public Lands," approved May 26th, 1873, and Acts prior thereto; and that he has not a Homestead other than the above.

AND also at the same time came and personally appeared Ole Nystel and Oscar Anderson two credible resident citizens of said County, to me well known, who being duly sworn, depose and say that N. L. Gureland the person first above named in this Affidavit; has actually settled upon and ^{improved} cultivated as a Homestead, the land surveyed for him on the 23^d day of May 1887 by the Surveyor aforesaid, for the period of three years, and they nor either of them have any interest in the said land.

Report of A. Sinclair showing how the corners
of Surveys contiguous to the Neils Lars Giveland
pre-emption in Bogus Co. were determined.

Witness tree at N.W. Cor. S. G. Fische & 1 tree at S.E. Corner
still standing Sept. 1890. From these two corners, ran
N 60° E & N 30° W. & where the two lines intersected made
Co. Anna witness tree ^{near} ~~at~~ this corner marked as called
for; but evidently done in last 2 or 3 years. Found
stumps at this corner which correspond with course &
distance. There are no known corners on either BDB
& C Surveys Nos 1 & 2. But there is a well known
spring on the division line of the two surveys.

Called for in the field notes & at which I found
a side line & fore & aft tree. From this call
I located the two ^{corners S.E. & N.W. of} above named surveys several
years ago. They have been fenced on any time. Within
a year a suit in the Dist. Court of Bogus on
the division line between the two, was instituted by
the party who own the South BDB & C. & the judgment
of the Court established this division line & consequently
the S.W. & N.W. corners of the two surveys just as I
had located them. The other surveys all homestead

claims have no witness trees but as the work is all recent found all the corners (rock piles) as called for in the field notes -

I found the East line of the Erick Erickson Survey 66000. instead of 65000. as called for - both witness trees good, but old pile of rocks at P. & L. corners & stump standing to correspond in course & distance - to have made for - The true relations (on the ground) are shown in this sketch between the surveys on the E & those on the West. The North line of the G. Gosche continued N 60° E is the North line of B. B. B. & Co. No. 2. The Heils Larson Gaveland Preemption claim here represented does not reach the P. Thompson Survey by 30000 or more - Figures enclosed in brackets indicate actual length -
