

H. Weeks a Surveyor of said County; that he has occupied and improved the same as a Homestead for a period of three consecutive years, beginning on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of May 1887 that he is a married man and that he makes affidavit for the purpose of obtaining a title to the same for a Homestead, under an Act supplementary to "An Act for the Benefit of Actual Occupants of the Public Lands," approved May 26th, 1873, and Acts prior thereto; and that he has not a Homestead other than the above.

a. Anna witness true <sup>now</sup> at his corner marked as called  
for; but evidently done in last 2 or 3 years. Found  
stumps at this corner which correspond with course &  
distance. There are no known corners on either BBB  
& C Survey No 1 & 2. but there is a well known  
Spring on the division line of the two surveys.

Called for in the field notes that which Anna  
a side line before staff true. From this call  
I located the two above named surveys several  
years ago. They have been fixed on my time. Within  
a year a suit in the Dist. Court of Boag Co. on  
the division line between the two, was instituted by
