Found the N.W. Cor. of Person's preemption witness tree called
for standing ran N 60° E course & distance called for on Per-
son's N. line. Found both witness trees called for at N.E.
Cor. but one of them not in position. Ran Person's E. line
& found his S.E. Cor. & witness tree claimed by him & called
for. Found S.W. Cor. of Person's preemption which is N.W.
Cor. Wm Winkler - both original witness trees called for in
Winkler standing & in right position. From this corner
ran N 60° E towards N.E. Cor. of said Winkler and at
64⁰⁰ over the distance called for found pile of rock
& both witness trees called for still standing - ran
back S 60° W - & at 457⁰⁰ found Nagler's S.W. Cor. as called
for & at 240⁰⁰ in same course Ilang's S.W. Cor.
and then found the Ilang W. line & the Person's E. line
63⁰⁰ apart. I also found the S.E. Cor. of the H.C. Wyatt
with the witness tree called for still standing & found this line

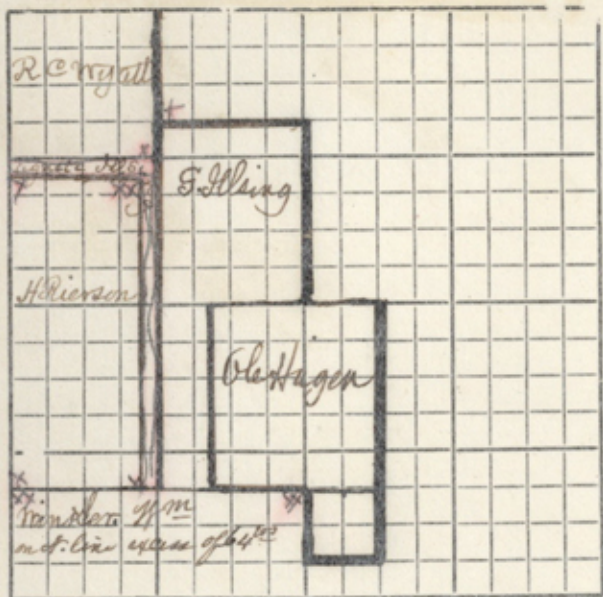

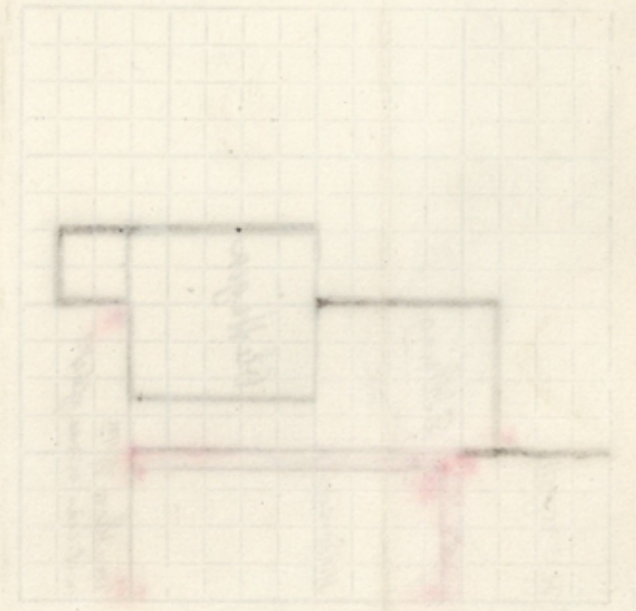
