

Report of the Surveyor who located the
W. J. Hastings Preemption Claim.

1st I found 1 orig. witness tree standing at N.W. Cor. Allison Arms or Aaron, marked as calls for in field notes ran S 60° W to N.W. Cor. Robert Grossman. 2nd located the S. line of the O.C. McPhail from N.W. Cor. which is well defined & of which there is no controversy Ran S 30° E 900^m found original Cor. as located - Continued this course S 30° E 300^m before striking S. line of Robert Grossman as just located - His line, ^{N. line Robert Grossman} is now fenced upon correct line. The field notes of the G. Col. vs H. R. Rd. Survey call for its S.E. Cor. in N. line of the Robt. Grossman but this is a clear mistake as the same call is for the O.C. McPhail Cor. The witness trees at S.W. Cor. S. Garsa are gone; but the N.E. cor. of said Garsa is settled by Nat. calls & is inky nable - From this Cor. S 30° E the distance gives out 146^m before getting to about S 60° W of the McPhail Cor.





This is to certify that J. G. H. Turner the County Surveyor of Bosque County Texas did on the 30th day of December A.D. 1802, go on the ground and make a survey of the North line of the Robert Crossman and South lines of the C.C + S.F.R.R. Co. No. 1 and Semore Garsee survey.

I begin at the N.E. corner of the Robert Crossman and the Allison Arms N.W. corner from which one of the live oaks is yet standing as called for in the field notes of the said Crossman and Arms survey N 40° 34' 46" marked T. The stump of the other was found as called for. Also the branch on the North line of the said Arms survey fits the call N 60° E 20 varas.

We ran thence S 60° E at 1165 varas a branch 2000 varas to the N.W. corner of said Crossman and N.E. corner of said Bridgman survey at a point N 30° E from the established S.W. and S.E. corners of said survey. Hence N 30° E 300 varas to the South line of the Semore Garsee survey; thence N 60° E passing the S.E. corner of the said Garsee and S.W. corner of the G.C + S.F.R.R. Co.
