Report of Surveyor making Preemption  
Survey for <sup>(Benjamin)</sup> Benf. Falkner in the Mountains  
9 M. S. of Meridian.

I began at S.E. Cor. Evan R Spencer Preemption  
a well defined Cor. & ran N 60° E across the  
S. S. Crabb rather more than distance called for  
to a pile of rock for S.W. Cor. Marion Taylor  
Preemption. This distance added to South W. S.,  
E. R. Spencer made 17<sup>m</sup> more than the Call for  
this line in G. C. & S. H. R. of Survey No. 1.

Thence ran S 30° E - passing N.W. Cor. J. L. Myers  
& S.W. Cor. same and at 50<sup>m</sup> farther South 30° E  
was at a point 60<sup>m</sup> N 60° E from N.E. Cor.

J. R. H. Spencer Preemption - a well defined Corner -  
Found N. line of H. C. Howard 150<sup>m</sup> S 30° E - of  
N.E. Cor. said Spencer. Line marked & fenced

Located Morris & Cum. Survey & found its West  
line distant 140<sup>m</sup> from E. line H. C. Howard

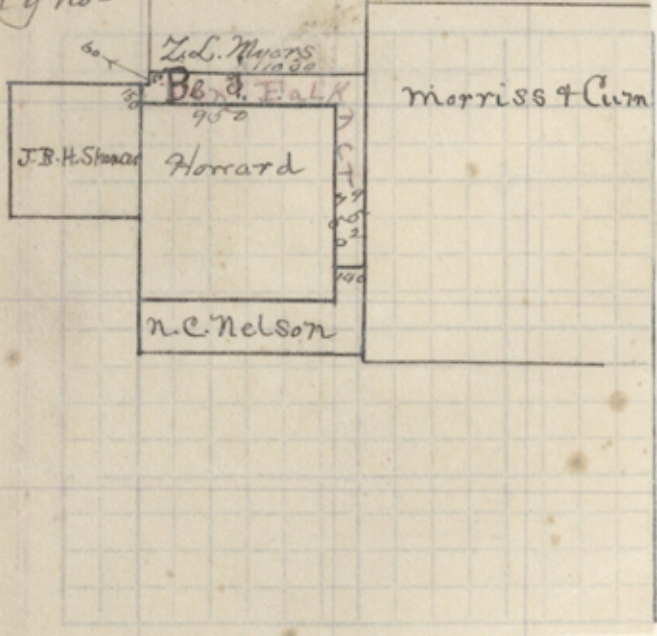

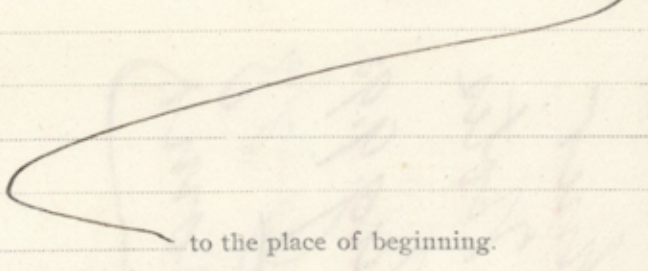
