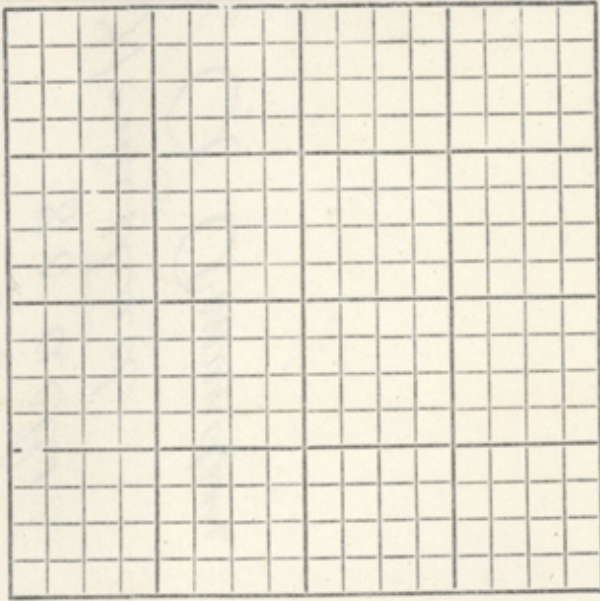

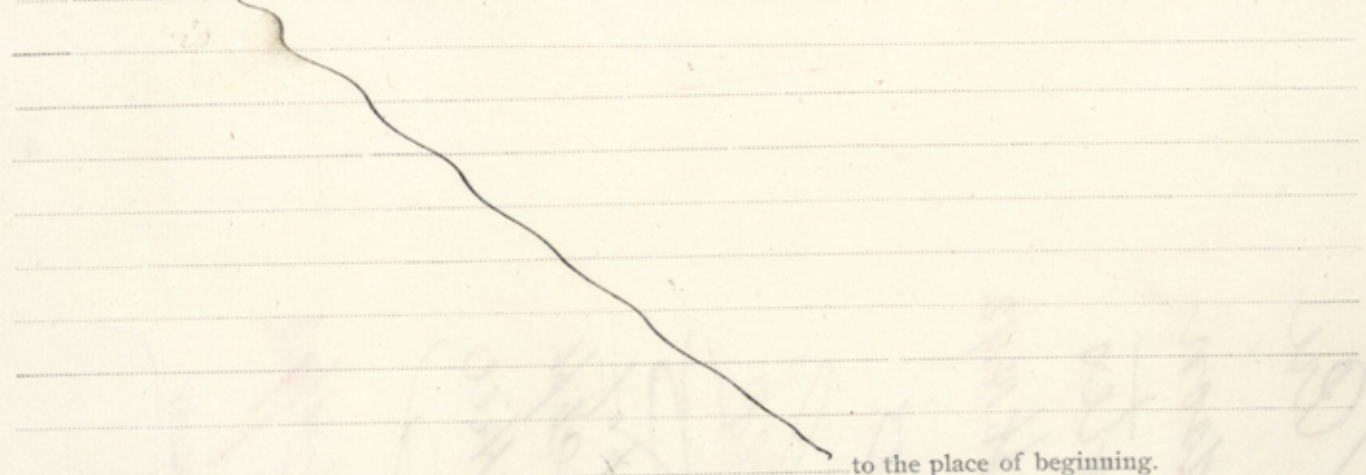

PROOF OF SETTLEMENT UNDER HOMESTEAD ACT.

THE STATE OF TEXAS, }

BEFORE ME, the undersigned, County Clerk in and for the County aforesaid, this day came and personally appeared Andrew Amundson, a resident citizen of said county, who being by me duly sworn, declares that he is a *bono fide* settler upon eighty acres of vacant public land, situated in said county, and surveyed for me A. Amundson on the 15th day of April 1887, by Jas. N. Weeks a surveyor of said county; that he has occupied and improved the same as a Homestead for a period of three consecutive years, beginning on the 15th day of April 1887, that he is unmarried, and that he makes this affidavit for the purpose of obtaining a title the same for a Homestead, under "An act for the Benefit of Actual Occupants of the Public Lands," approved May 26th, 1873, and Acts prior thereto; and that he has not a Homestead other than the above.

And also at the same time came and personally appeared Ole Amundson and John Amundson, two credible resident citizens of said county, to me well known, who being sworn, dispose and say that Andrew Amundson the person first above named in this affidavit, has actually settled upon and cultivated as a Homestead the land surveyed for him on the 15th day of May 1887, by the surveyor aforesaid, for the period of three years, and they nor either of them have any interest in the said land.
