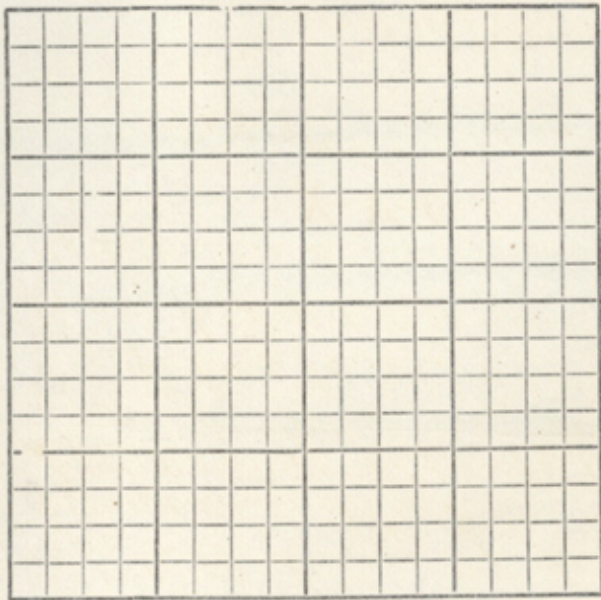

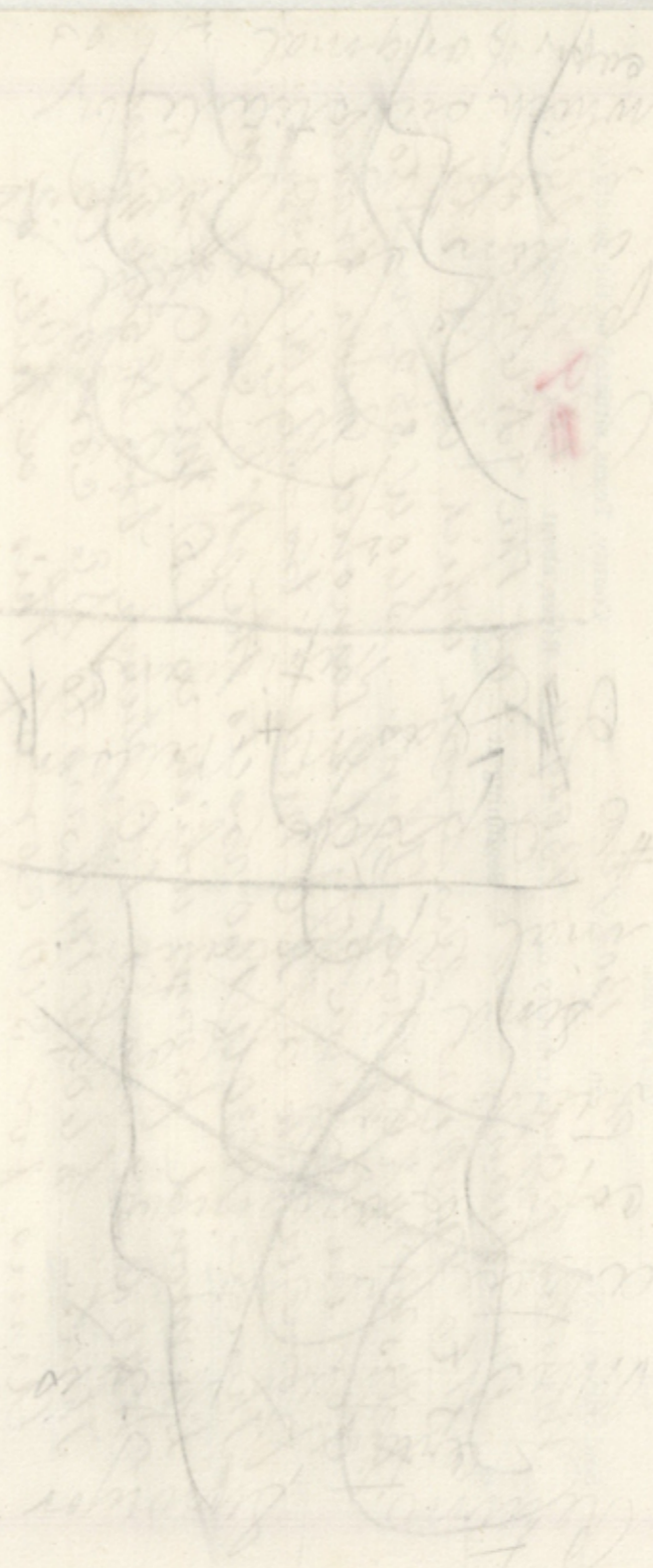

to me known, who after being by me duly sworn, upon his oath deposes and says: that he is now a bona fide settler upon 160 acres of Land, that he believes to be of

the public vacant lands of the State of Texas; that he is improving said land for a Homestead, and has no other; and further that he is a married man

and makes this Affidavit for the purpose of obtaining a Home. Said Land is situated in Bosque County, about 10 miles West from Meridian, on the waters of Mustang Creek:

PROOF OF SETTLEMENT UNDER HOMESTEAD ACT.

THE STATE OF TEXAS, }
County of Boque

BEFORE ME, the undersigned, County Clerk in and for the County aforesaid, this day came and personally appeared Peder Pederson, a resident citizen of said county, who being by me duly sworn, declares that he is a *bono fide* settler upon 160 acres of vacant public land, situated in said county, and surveyed for him on the 7th day of February 18 89, by J. N. Weeks (by his deputy) a surveyor of said county; that he has occupied and improved the same as a Homestead for a period of three consecutive years, beginning on the 23^d day of December 18 88, that he is married, and that he makes this affidavit for the purpose of obtaining a title the same for a Homestead, under "An act for the Benefit of Actual Occupants of the Public Lands," approved May 26th, 1873, and Acts prior thereto; and that he has not a Homestead other than the above.

And also at the same time came and personally appeared John Hagen and John Amundson, two credible resident citizens of said county, to me well known, who being sworn, dispose and say that Peder Pederson the person first above named in this affidavit, has actually settled upon and cultivated as a Homestead the land surveyed for him on the 7th day of February 18 89, by the surveyor aforesaid, for the period of three years, and they nor either of them have any interest in the said land.
