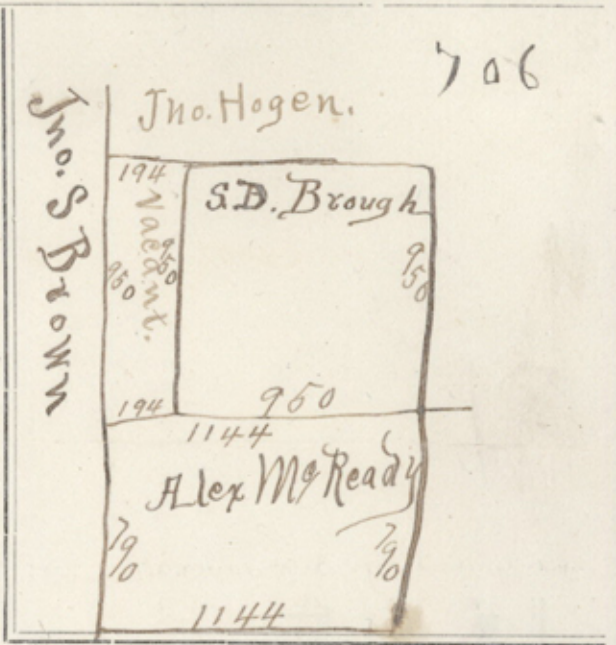

E. line of said Brown to corner. Thence
N 60° E 194 rods to the place of beginning

and I further state that I claim the same for myself, in good faith, under the laws granting Homestead donations; that I am

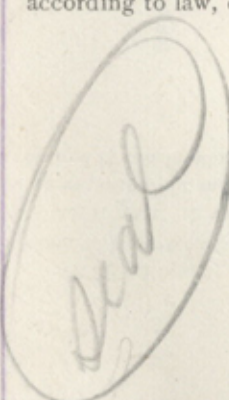

DUTY OF THE SURVEYOR.

ARTICLE 3940. Said application shall be filed with the said Surveyor, and recorded by him in a well-bound book kept for recording pre-emption and homestead applications; and the said Surveyor shall give a receipt therefore, if desired.

ART. 3941. It shall be the duty of the Surveyor of the proper District or County, to convey the land described in the application aforesaid, as soon as practicable, and within twelve months after the date of said application, and the field notes thereof shall be certified to, recorded and mapped, as required by law in other cases, the applicant paying all legal Surveyor's fees.

PROOF OF SETTLEMENT UNDER HOMESTEAD ACT.

THE STATE OF TEXAS, }

BEFORE ME, the undersigned, County Clerk in and for the County aforesaid, this day came and personally appeared Antone Peterson, a resident citizen of said county, who being by me duly sworn, declares that he is a bona fide settler upon 32.6 acres of vacant public land, situated in said county, and surveyed for Antone Peterson on the 2nd day of January 1895¹⁹⁰, by Tom L. Greer a surveyor of said county; that he has occupied and improved the same as a Homestead for a period of three consecutive years, beginning on the 2^d day of January 1895¹⁹⁰, that he is a single man, and that he makes this affidavit for the purpose of obtaining a title the same for a Homestead, under "An act for the Benefit of Actual Occupants of the Public Lands," approved May 26th, 1873, and Acts prior thereto; and that he has not a Homestead other than the above.

And also at the same time came and personally appeared Herman Aars and John Buswold, two credible resident citizens of said county, to me well known, who being sworn, dispose and say that Antone Peterson the person first above named in this affidavit, has actually settled upon and cultivated as a Homestead the land surveyed for him on the 2^d day of January 1895¹⁹⁰, by the surveyor aforesaid, for the period of three years, and they nor neither of them have any interest in the said land.
