PROOF OF SETTLEMENT UNDER HOMESTEAD ACT.

THE STATE OF TEXAS, }

County of Bosque }

BEFORE ME, the undersigned, County Clerk in and for the County aforesaid, this day came and personally appeared Mrs Ida Lindmark, a resident citizen of said county, who being by me duly sworn, declares that she is a *bono fide* settler upon 8.3 acres of vacant public land, situated in said county, and surveyed for her on the 8¹² day of April 1889, by W. C. Barrett, Deputy Co. Surveyor a surveyor of said county; that she has occupied and improved the same as a Homestead for a period of three consecutive years, beginning on the 8 day of July 1889, that she is a widow, and that she makes this affidavit for the purpose of obtaining a title the same for a Homestead, under "An act for the Benefit of Actual Occupants of the Public Lands," approved May 26th, 1873, and Acts prior thereto; and that she has not a Homestead other than the above.

And also at the same time came and personally appeared R. B. Harris and J. E. Harris, two credible resident citizens of said county, to me well known, who being sworn, depose and say that Mrs Ida Lindmark the person first above named in this affidavit, has actually settled upon and cultivated as a Homestead the land surveyed for her on the 8 day of April 1889, by the surveyor aforesaid, for the period of three years, and they nor either of them have any interest in the said land.
