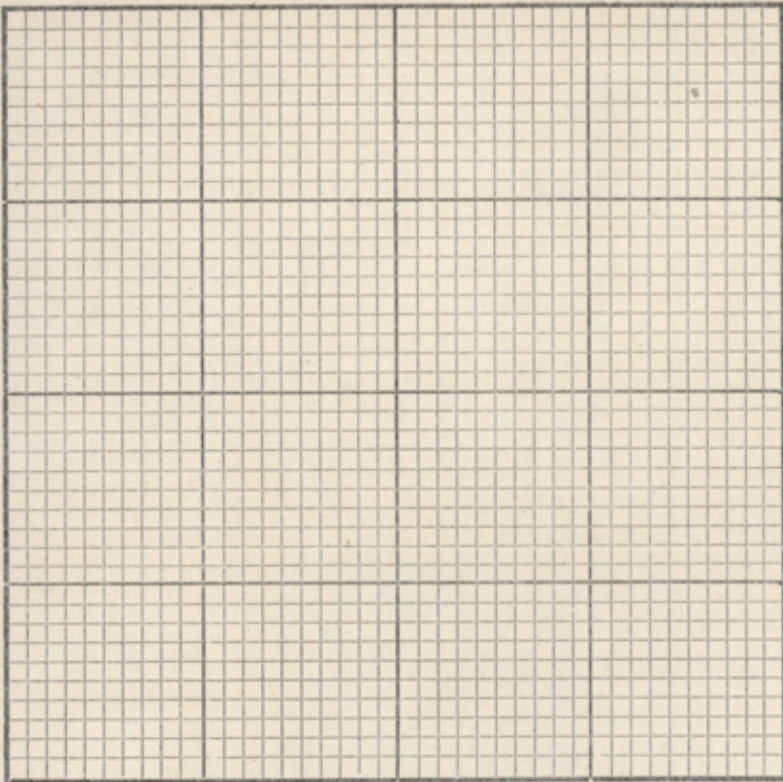

DUTY OF THE SURVEYOR.

ARTICLE 3940. Said application shall be filed with the said Surveyor, and recorded by him in a well bound book, kept for recording pre-emption and homestead applications; and the said Surveyor shall give a receipt therefor, if desired.
ARTICLE 3941. It shall be the duty of the Surveyor of the proper district or county to survey the land described in the application aforesaid, as soon as practicable and within twelve months after the date of said application, and the field notes thereof shall be certified to, recorded and mapped, as required by law in other cases, the applicant paying all legal surveyor's fees.

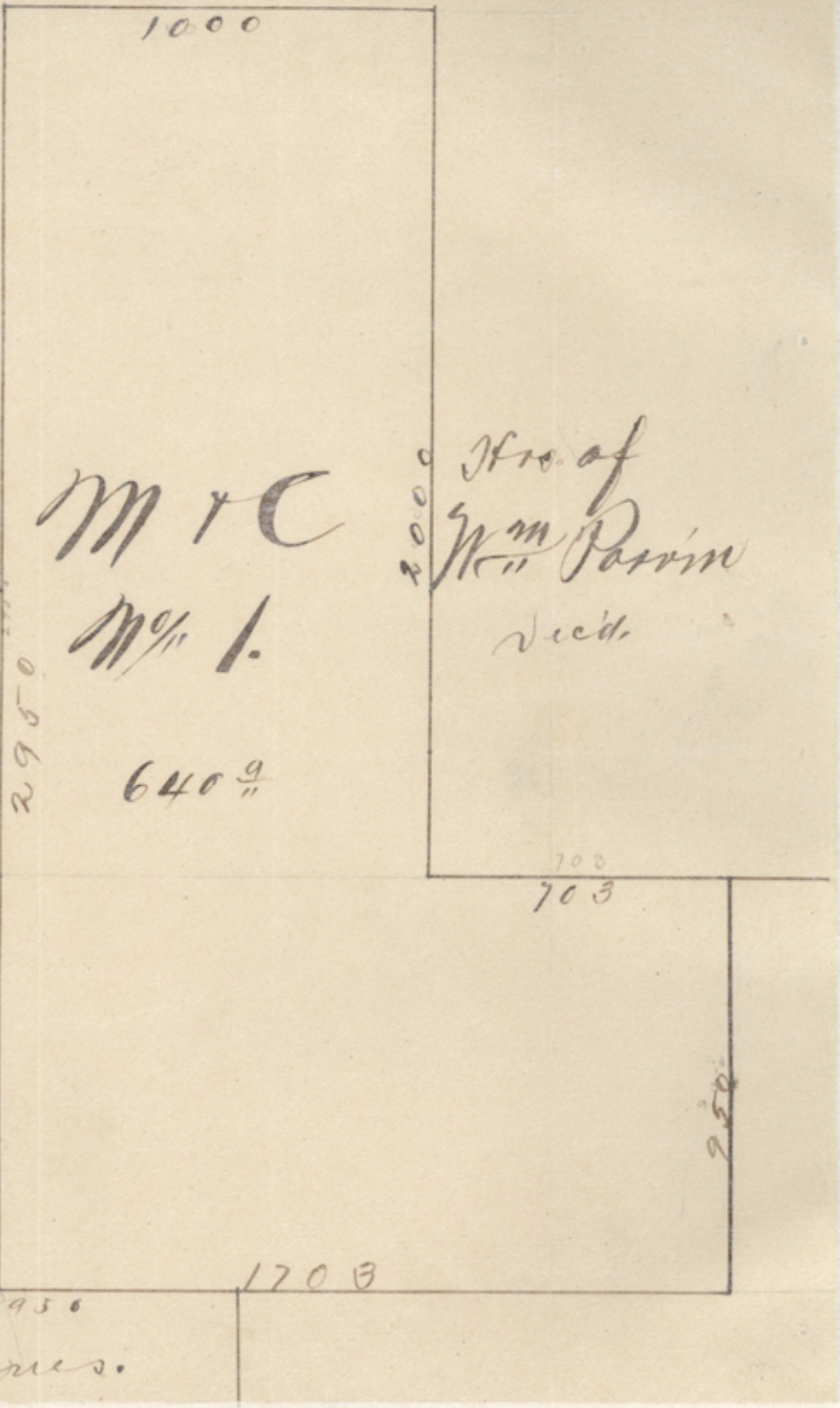

BEFORE ME, the undersigned, ~~County Clerk~~ in and for the County aforesaid, this day came and personally appeared L. H. Hefflin, a resident citizen of said county, who being by me duly sworn, declares that he is a *bono fide* settler upon 72 acres of vacant public land, situated in said county, and surveyed for L. H. Hefflin on the 25th day of October 1895, by Sam L. Brewer a surveyor of said county; that he has occupied and improved the same as a Homestead for a period of three consecutive years, beginning on the 25th day of October 1895, that he is 36 years old ^{married} and that he makes this affidavit for the purpose of obtaining a title the same for a Homestead, under "An act for the Benefit of Actual Occupants of the Public Lands," approved May 26th, 1873, and Acts prior thereto; and that he has not a Homestead other than the above.

And also at the same time came and personally appeared W. F. Walling and J. J. Walling, two credible resident citizens of said county, to me well known, who being sworn, dispose and say that L. H. Hefflin the person first above named in this affidavit, has actually settled upon and cultivated as a Homestead the land surveyed for him on the 25th day of October 1895, by the surveyor aforesaid, for the period of three years, and they nor either of them have any interest in the said land.
