DUTY OF THE SURVEYOR.

ARTICLE 8940. Said application shall be filed with the said Surveyor, and recorded by him in a well bound book, kept for recording pre-emption and homestead applications; and the said Surveyor shall give a receipt therefor, if desired.

ARTICLE 8941. It shall be the duty of the Surveyor of the proper district or county to survey the land described in the application aforesaid, as soon as practicable and within twelve months after the date of said application, and the field notes thereof shall be certified to, recorded and mapped, as required by law in other cases, the applicant paying all legal surveyor's fees.

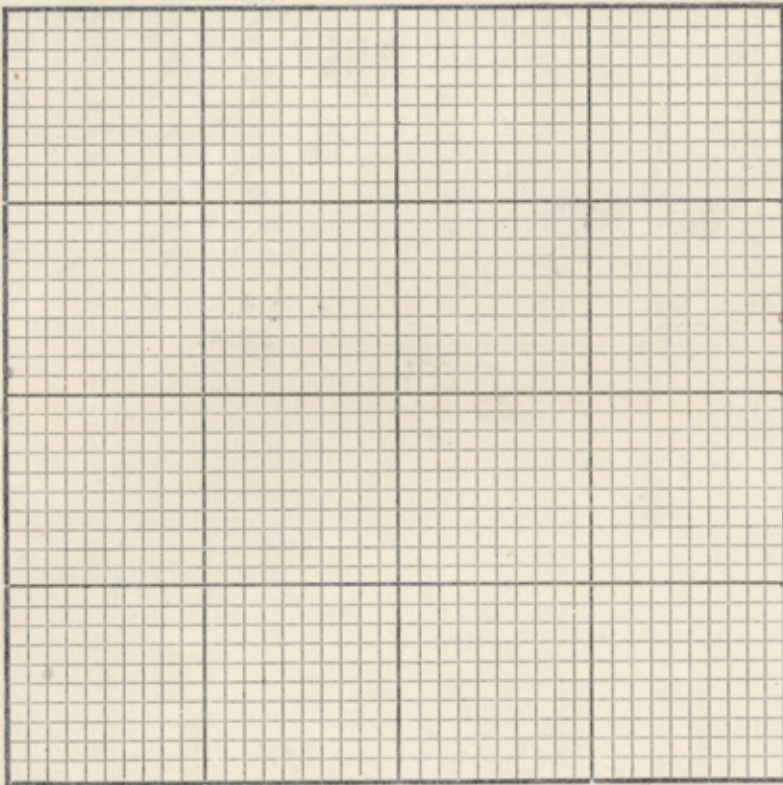
