193 for three hundred and twenty acres

granted.

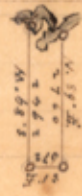

for 320 acres of Land, No 31 Class
and dated the 30th day of November
A D 1838 - was issued by the board of
Land Commissioners for Grimes County
to Raleigh W Smith upon his con-
ditional Certificate for 320 acres of
Land No 193 Class - and dated
the 11th day of November A D 1839 - is-
sued by the board of Land Commission-
ers for Montgomery County, Satisfac-
tory proof having been made to this
Court that said Unconditional certifi-
cate had issued as aforesaid previous
to the destruction of the County Records
in December A D 1848 -
