THAT *Edley Montgomery* having served faithfully and honorably for the term of *three* months from the *first* day of *July 1835* until the *thirtieth* day of *Sept 1836* and being honorably discharged from the *Army of Texas* is entitled to *thirty* Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his CERTIFICATE.

And the said *E Montgomery* is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same, and exercise all rights of ownership over it:

This CERTIFICATE will be transferable by a deed before any competent authority, with witnesses to the same.

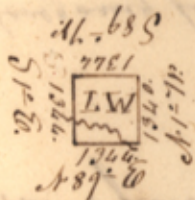
