Know all men to whom these presents shall come:

THAT *John Montgomery* having served faithfully and honorably for the term of *Three* months from the *Thirtieth* day of *March 1836* until the *Thirtieth* day of *May 1836* and being honorably discharged from the *Army of Texas* is entitled to *Three hundred thirty* Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his CERTIFICATE.

And the said *John Montgomery* is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same, and exercise all rights of ownership over it:

This CERTIFICATE will be transferable by a deed before any competent authority, with-witnesses to the same.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand, at *Houston* *Columbia*, the *Twenty-fifth* day of *January* 183*8*

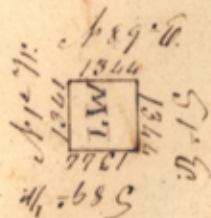
