That William Miller having served faithfully and honorably for the term of Ten Months from the 11th day of January, until the twelfth day of March 1837 and having been honorably discharged is entitled to four hundred eighty additional Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his CERTIFICATE.

And the said William Miller is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same, and to exercise all rights of ownership over it.

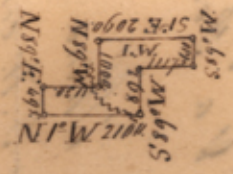

by Bernard E. Bee Sec. of War, entitling
me to 480 acre land for services in the Army
of Texas, to have and to hold and to
exercise all rights of ownership over it.
and I hereby bind myself, my heirs and
administrators to defend the title of said
Davis to said land certificate against
the claim or claims of any person or persons
whomsoever, when legally called upon.
