And the said *J Hadley* is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same, and exercise all rights of ownership over it:

This CERTIFICATE will be transferable by a deed before any competent authority, with witnesses to the same.

Survey for Joshua Hadley 320 Acres of Land situated on the E. side of the Navasoto River. Being the quantity of Land to which he is entitled by virtue of Land warrant No. 2113 dated the 26th day of January 1838 issued to the said Joshua Hadley. Beginning on the W. side of C. Campbell Survey at the N. E. corner of Grantham H. Hadley Survey at a Stake from which a Post Oak 12 inches diameter marked H bears N. 43° W. 13 2/10 varas distant, and a Post Oak 9 inches diameter marked H bears N. 9° W. 10 varas distant, and a Post Oak 20 inches diameter marked H bears N. 25° W. 17 varas distant

Varas T. Thence N. 71° W.
 1050 to the East bank of the Navasoto River at a Post from which a black Gum 16 inches diam. marked H bears S. 50° E. 2 3/10 varas distant and an Elm 10 inches diameter marked H bears S. 58° E. 3 4/10 varas distant, and a black Gum 30 inches diam. marked H bears N. 58° W. 6/10 varas distant.

Thence S. 19° W. with the W. boundary line of C. Campbell Survey.

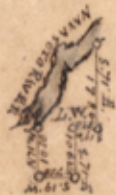
