Survey for the Heirs of William Peterson Dec^d 320 Acres of Land situated on the East side of the Navasoto River. Being the quantity of Land to which they are entitled by virtue of a Land Warrant No. 5068 dated at Houston the 13th day of December 1838.

Beginning on the South side of L. Cottle (J. J. Hutchinson Assign^y Survey at the NW corner of A. Song's head right Survey of one third of a Section of Land at a Stake from which a Post Oak 24 inches diameter marked WP bears S. 38° W. 8 yards, and a Post Oak 16 inches diameter marked WP bears S. 53° W. 19 varas distant. Thence S. 9° W.

Case of the County and the Republic aforesaid my true and lawful Attorney for me and in my name and for my use, to apply to the proper Officer of the said Republic and to ask and receive the Patent for the Land surveyed on and for the Heirs of William Peterson decas.^d Bounty Land Certificate N^o. 5068 dated at Houston the 13th day of December 1838 For Three Hundred and Twenty Acres of Bounty Land, (I the said John Peterson being the only legal Heir of William Peterson decas.^d as aforesaid) The situation of the land will fully appear by reference to the Surveyors Field Notes Recorded in the County Surveyors Office for Montgomery County. And in my name make seal and deliver and do all lawful Acts and things whatsoever concerning the procuring for me and in my name as the only surviving Legal Heir of William Peterson deceased or in the name of the Heirs of William Peterson decas.^d a Patent for the land surveyed as aforesaid in every respect as fully as I myself might or could do were I personally present for the purpose aforesaid. And by these Presents allowing whatsoever my Attorney shall in my name lawfully do or cause to be done in and by virtue of these Presents.
