That *Samuel News* ————— having served faithfully and honorably for the term of *twenty four* Months from the *15th* day of *Jan'y* 1837 — until the *fifteenth* — day of *Janu*ary 1839 — and having *been* honorably *discharged* — is entitled to *twelve hundred & eighty* Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his **CERTIFICATE.**

And the said *Samuel News* is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same, and to exercise all rights of ownership over it.

Warrant for William Walker

Being a part of the quantity of Land to which he is entitled by virtue of Land Warrant N<sup>o</sup>. 7036. Dated the 18<sup>th</sup> day of January 1834 issued to William Walker for 1280 Acres of land and by him transferred to the said William Walker.
