 this Country in Decr. 1821 ——— and that she
 is a widow woman and entitled to One labor
 of land upon the Condition of paying
 at the rate of Three 50/100 dollars for every labor
 of Irrigable land, Two 50/100 Dollars for every
 labor of Temporal or arable land and one 20/100
 dollar for every labor of Pasture land, which may
 be contained in the Survey secured to said
 Mrs. Shannon by this Certificate.
