Labor of Lands upon the condition of paying at the rate of Three 50/100 dollars for every labor of Irigable land, Two 50/100 dollars for every labor of Arable or Temporal lands and one 20/100 dollar for every labor of Pasture lands which may be contained in the Survey secured to him by the Certificate.

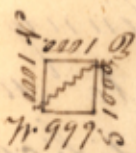
